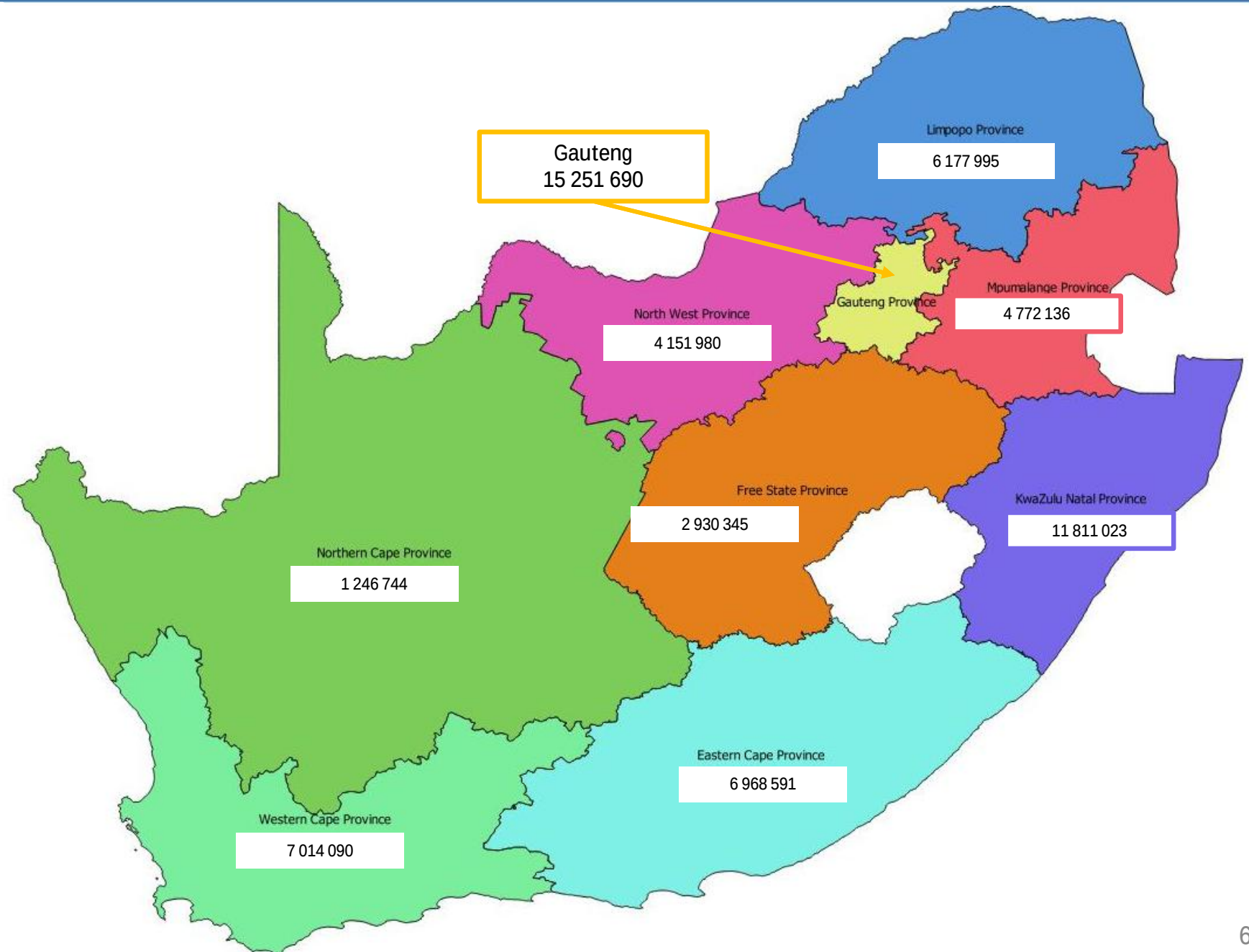

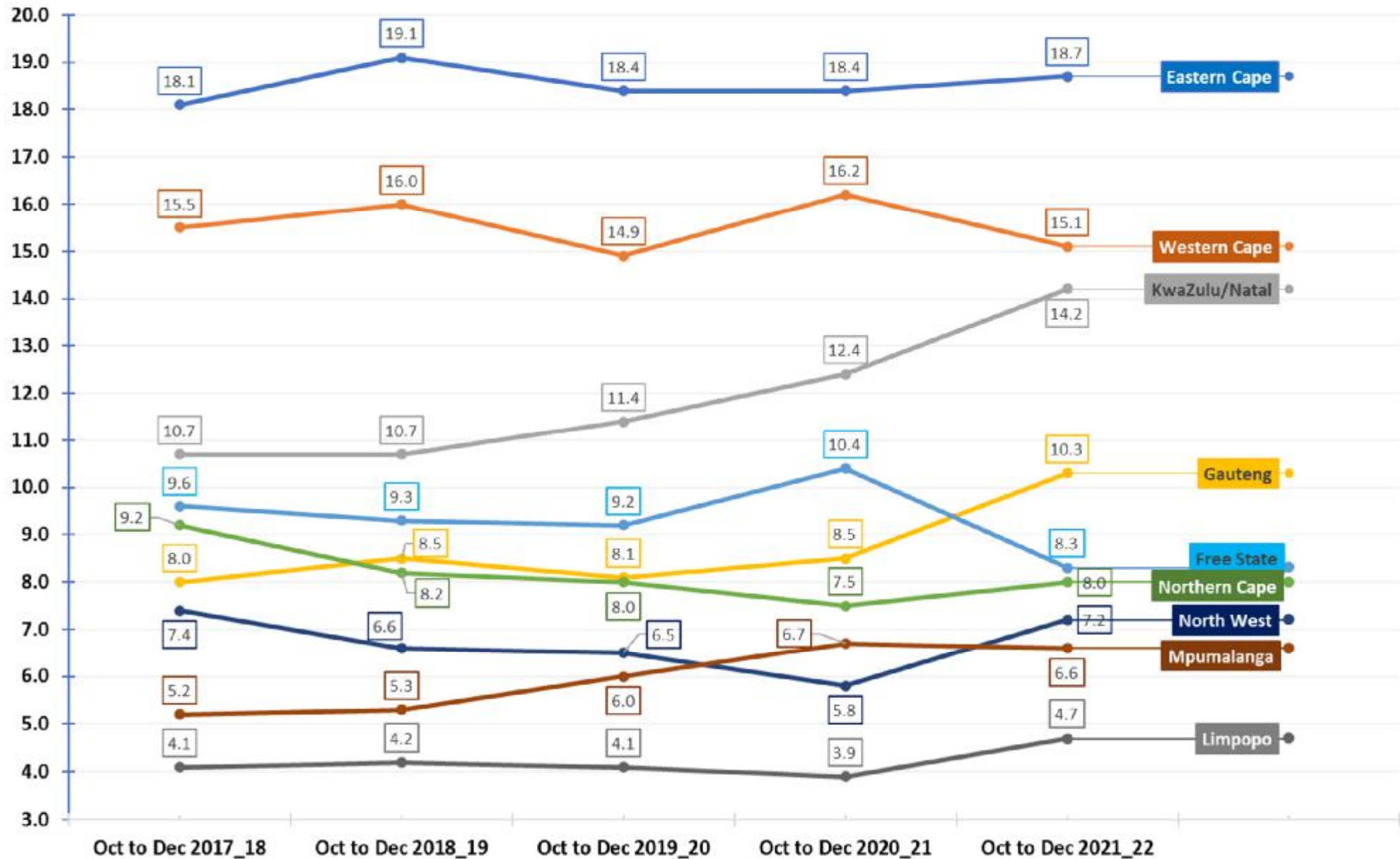

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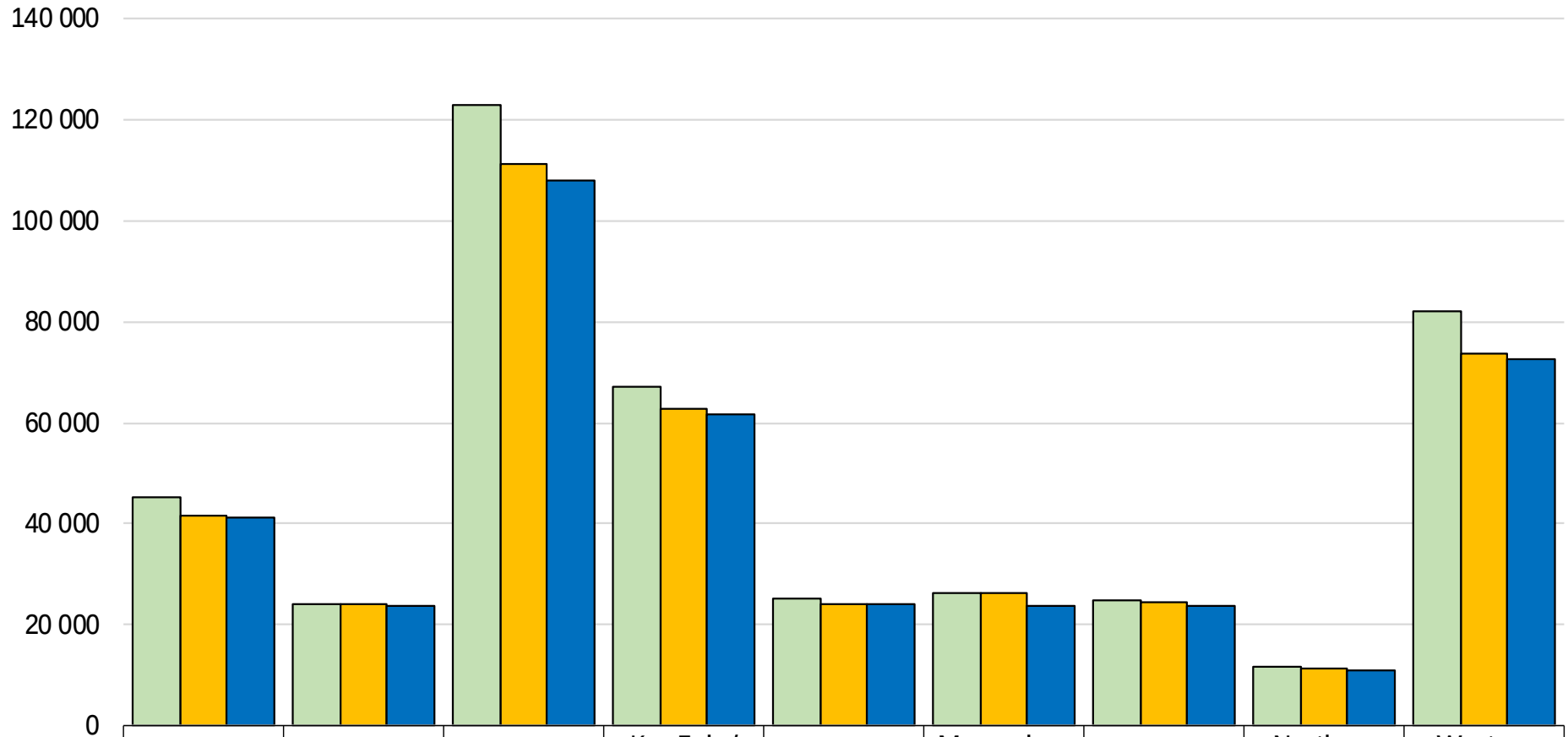

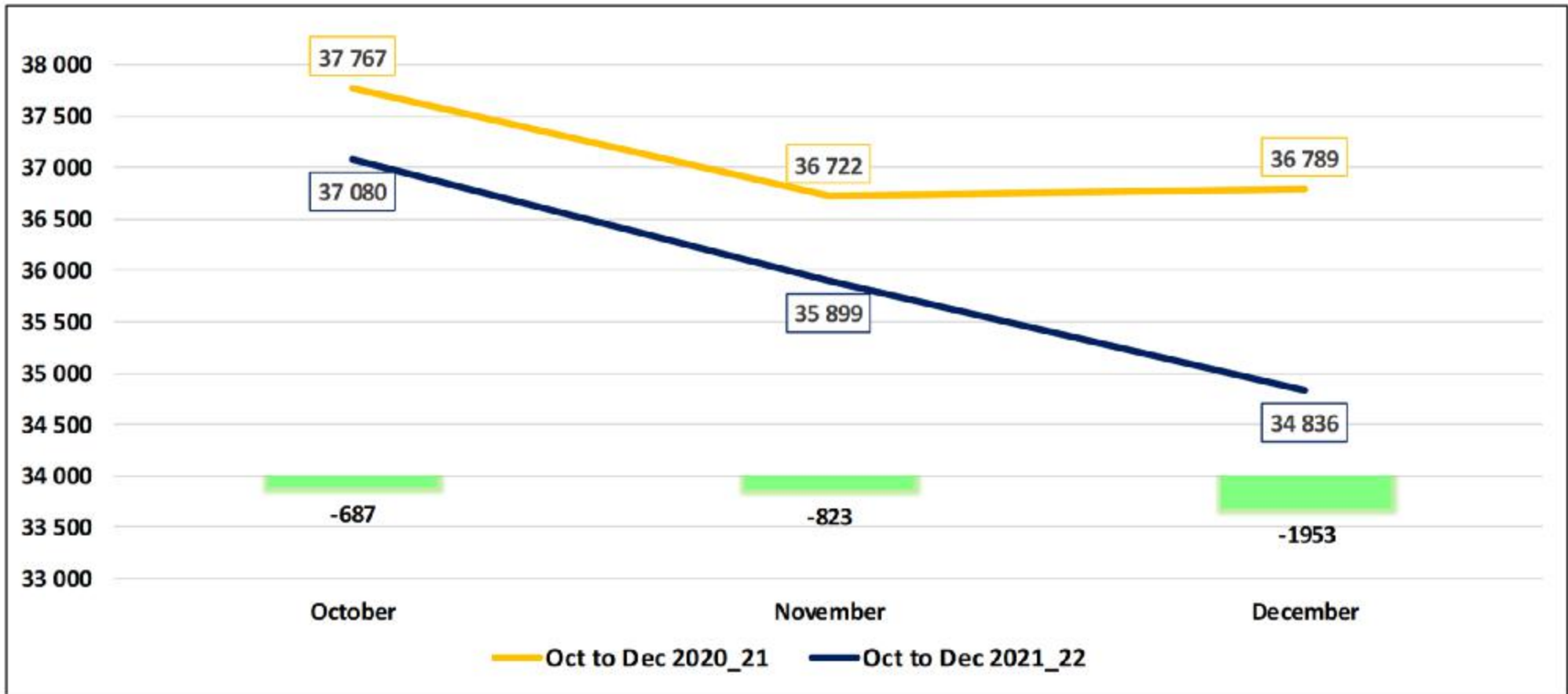

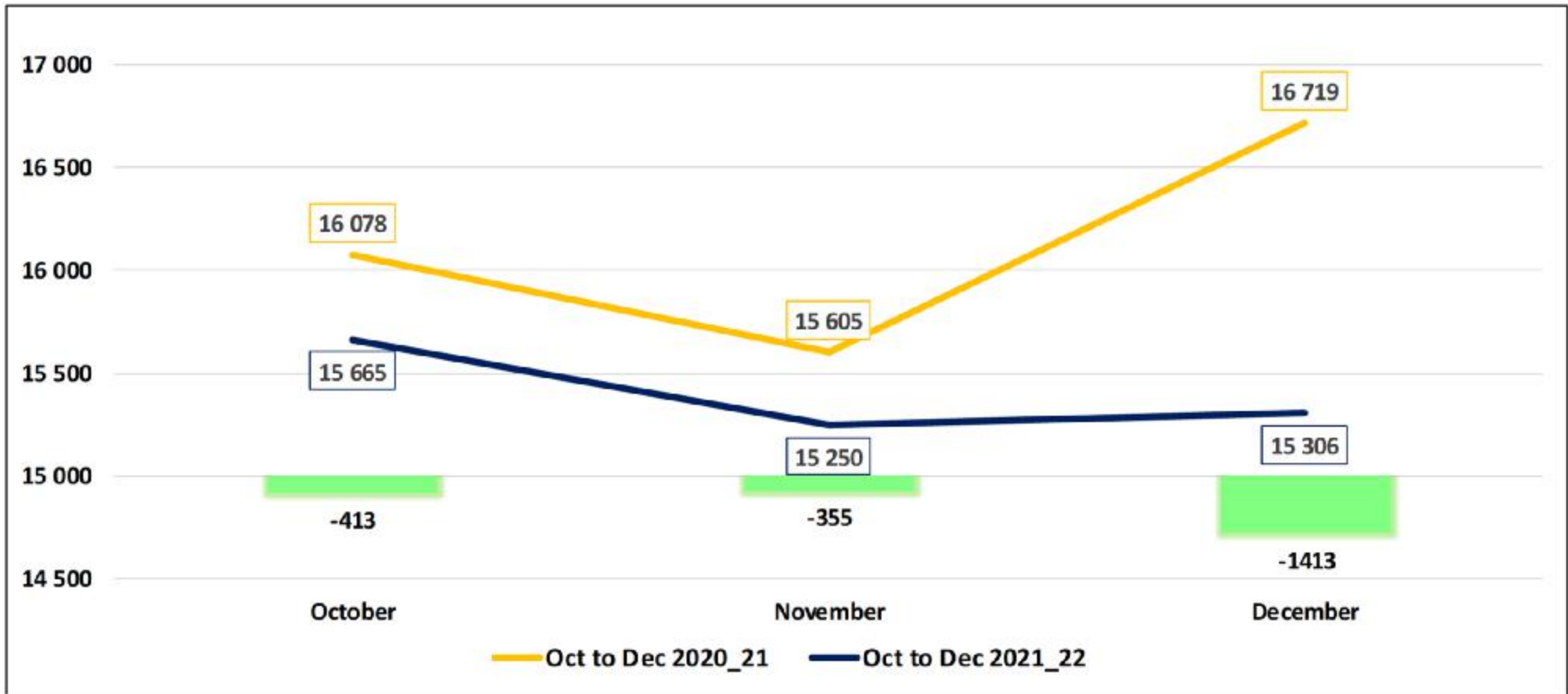

Trend per month – 2 years (District table – quarterly - 3 years)

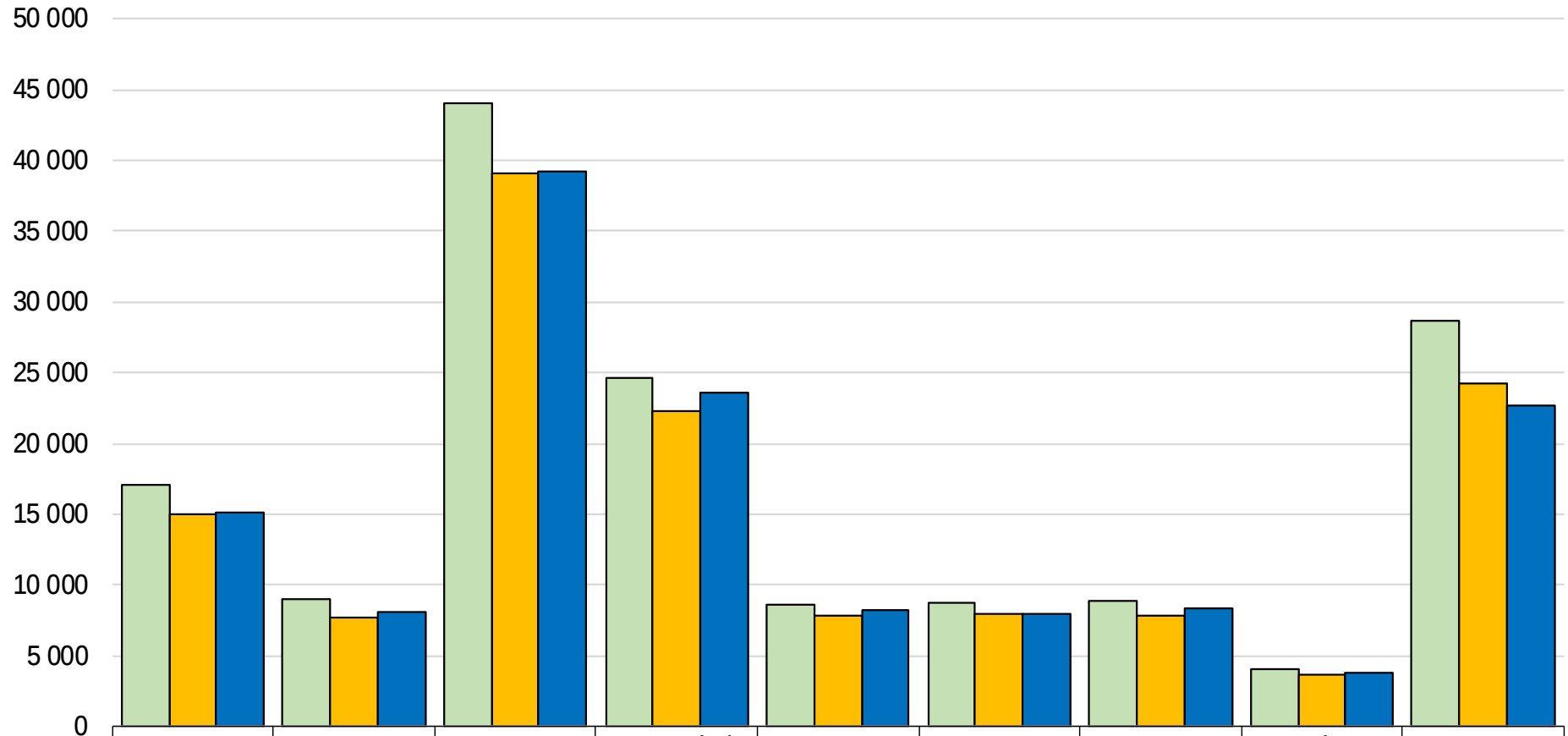

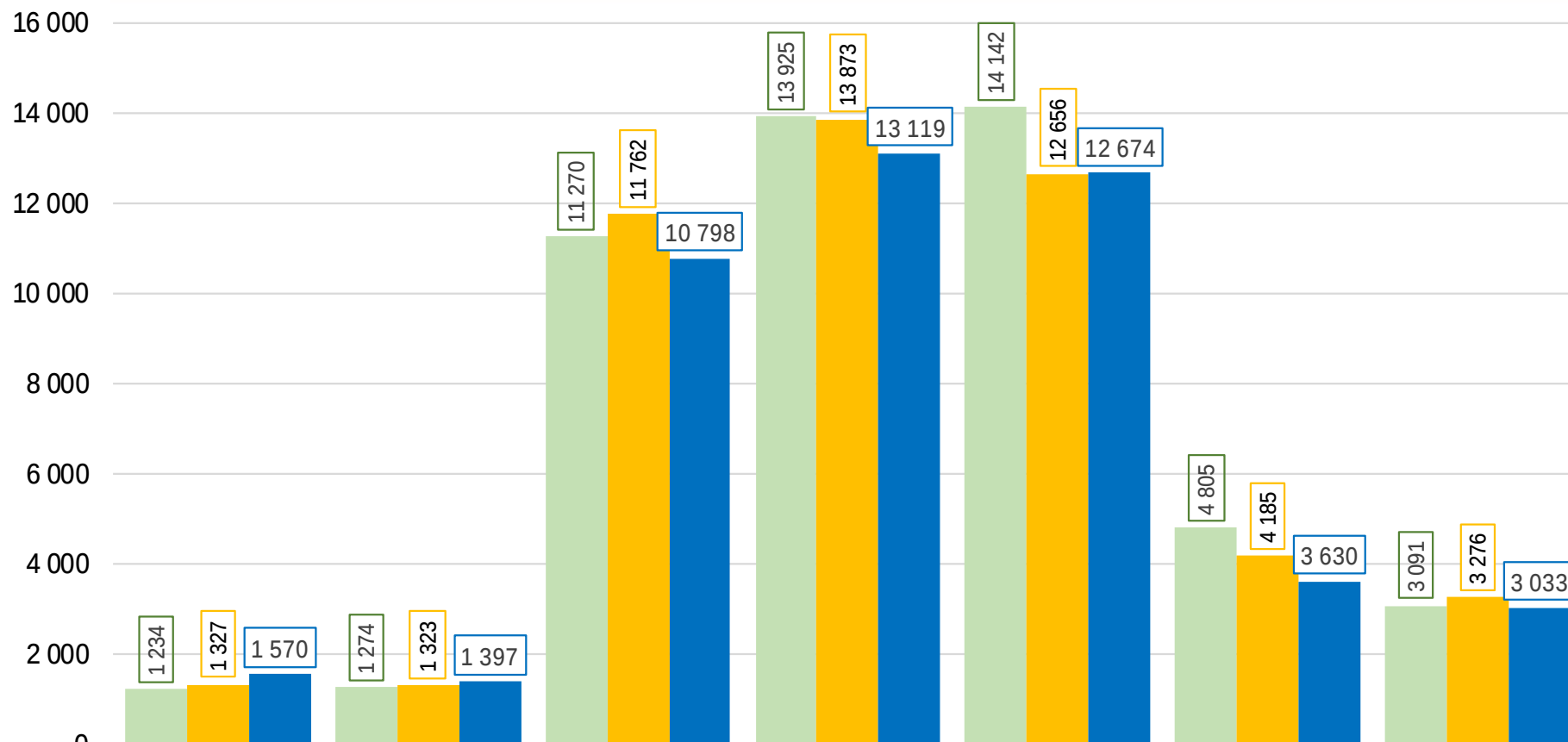

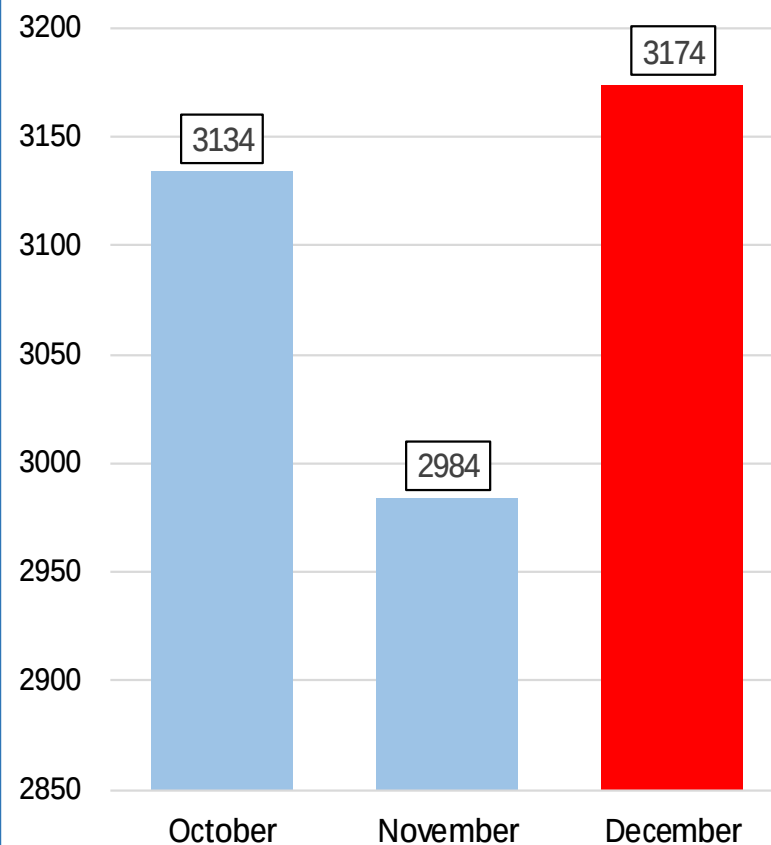

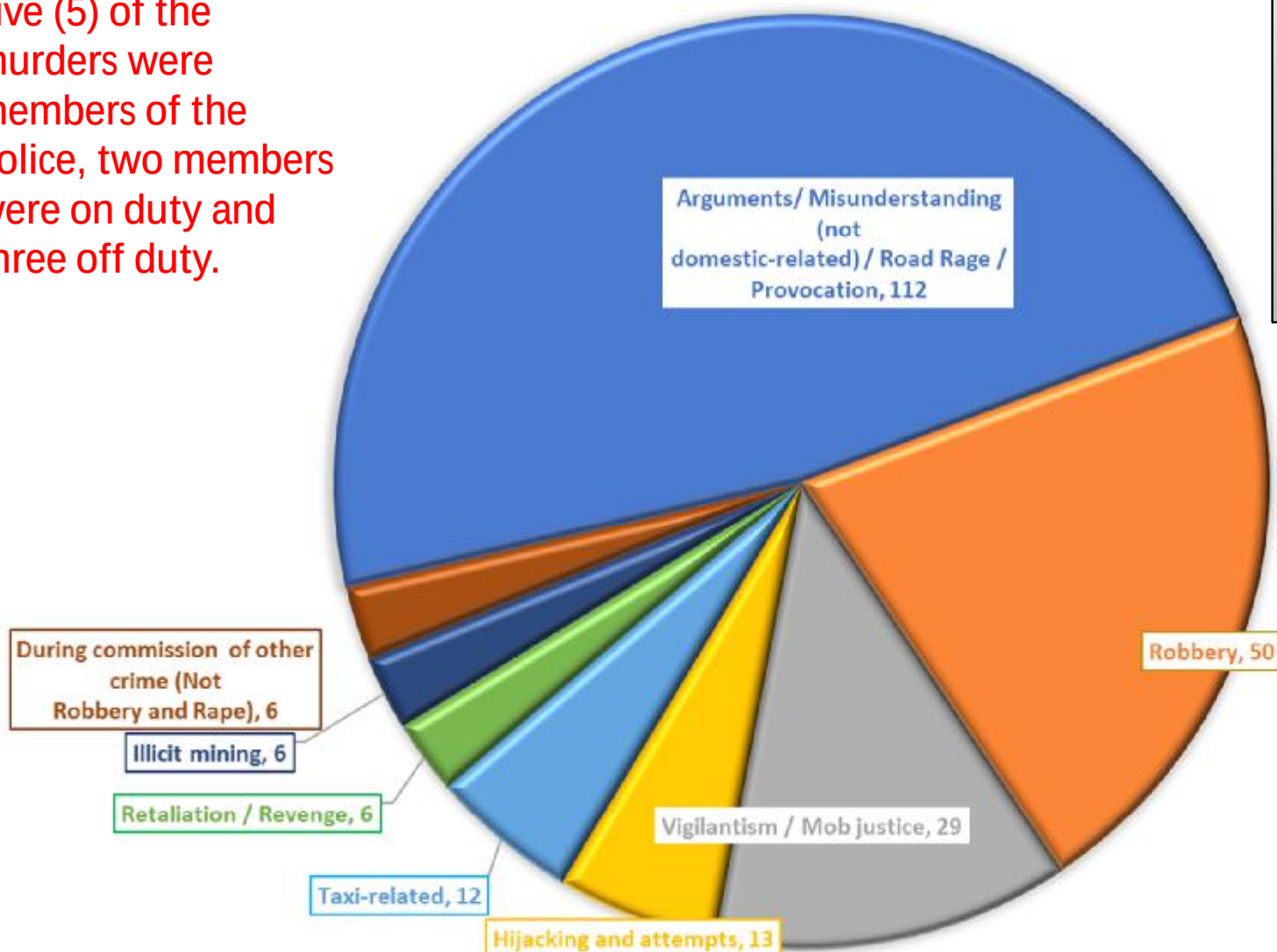

Trend per month – 2 years (District table – quarterly - 3 years)



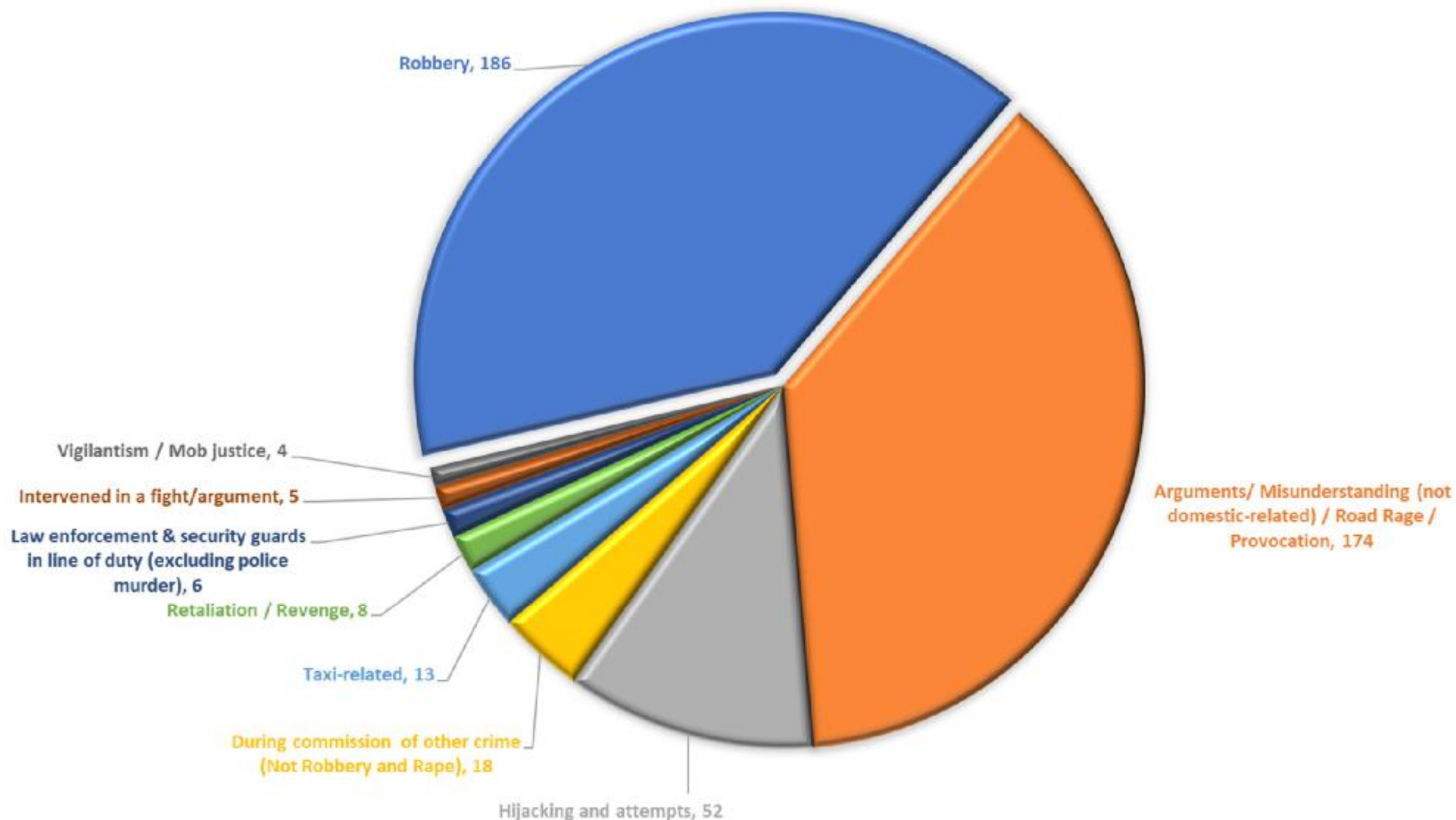

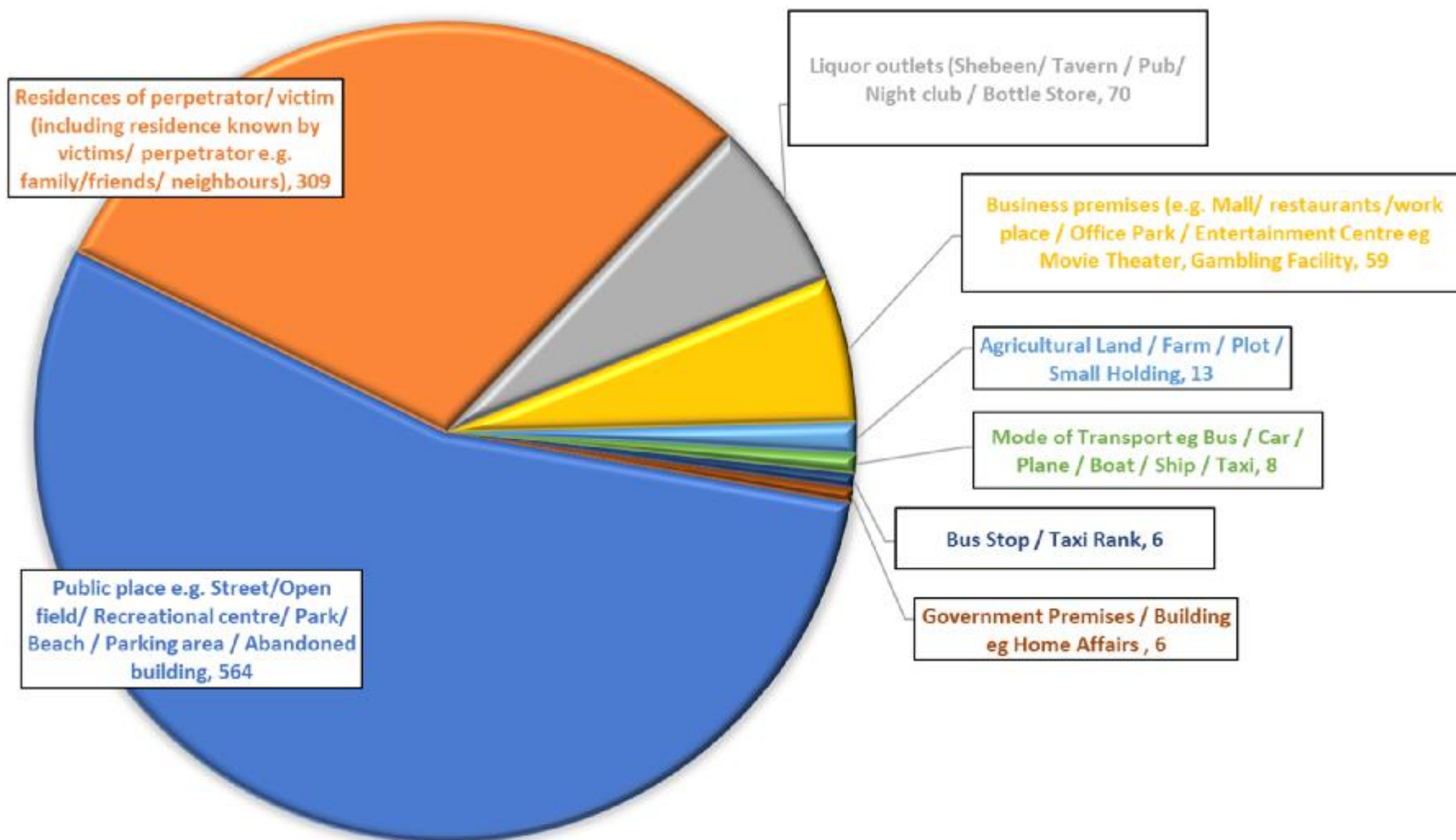

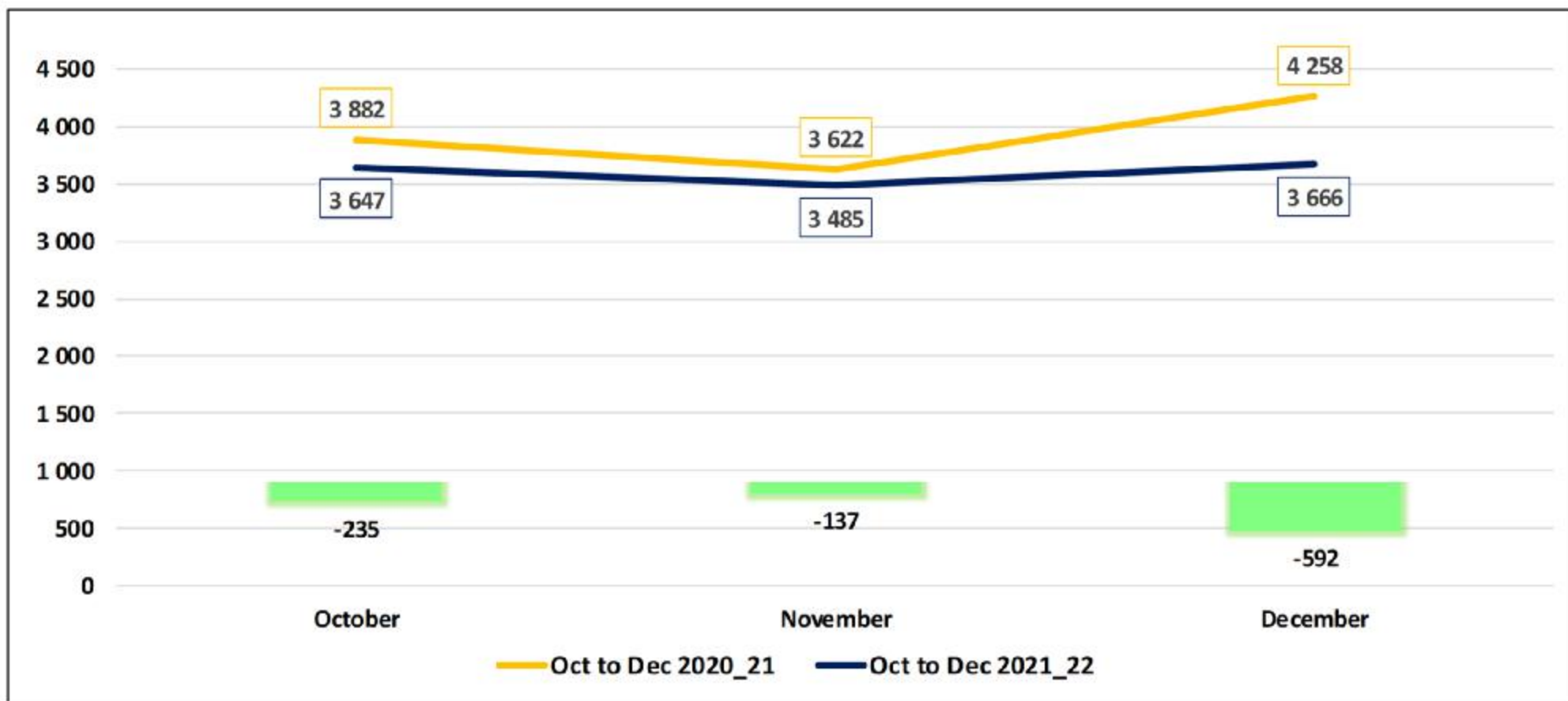

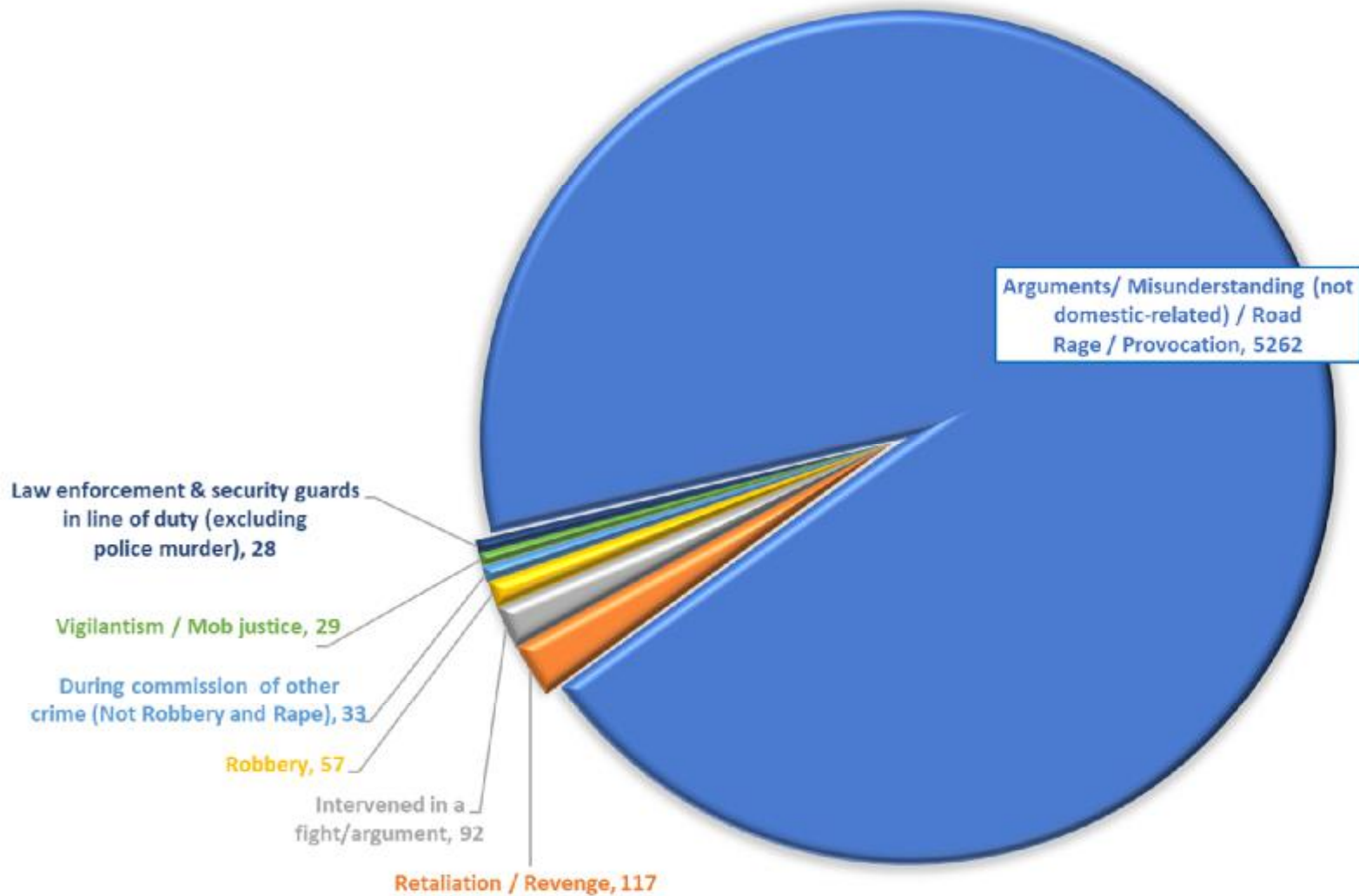

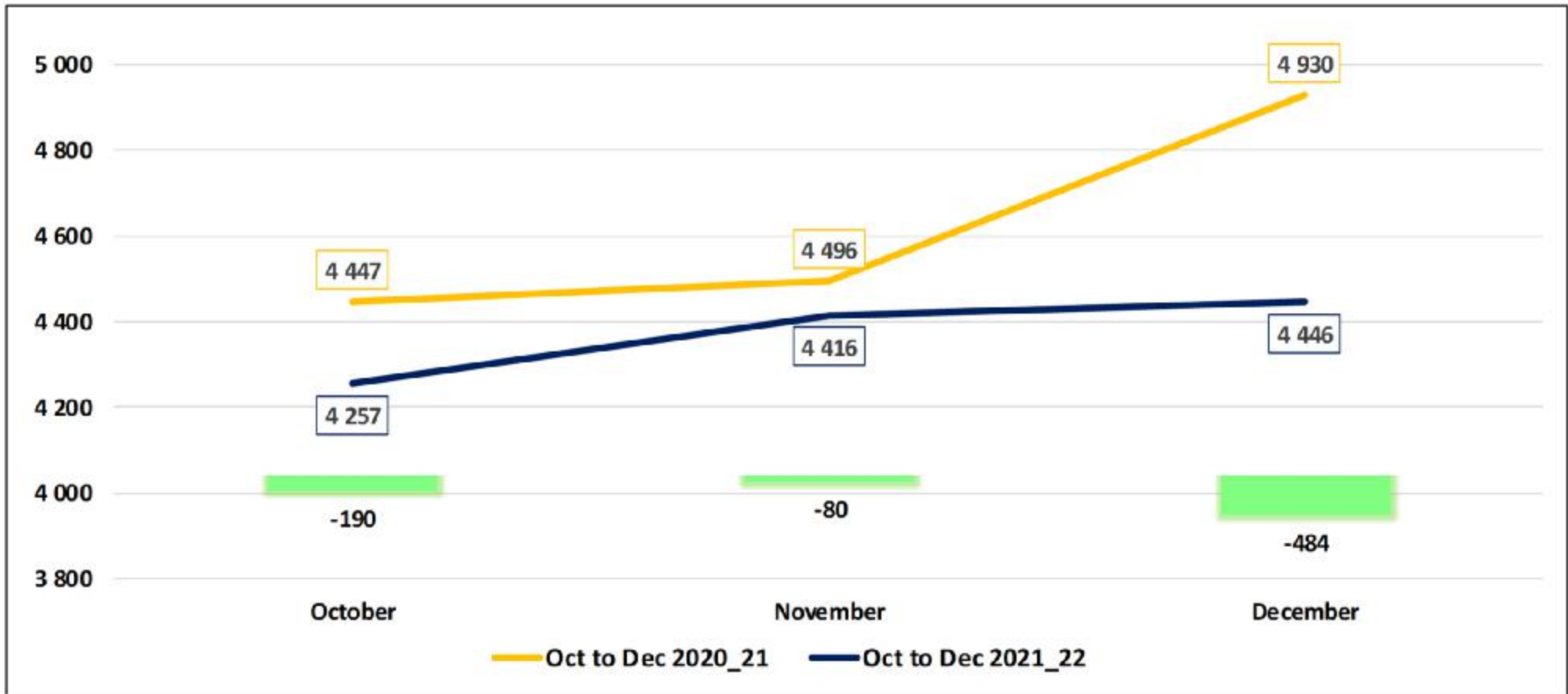

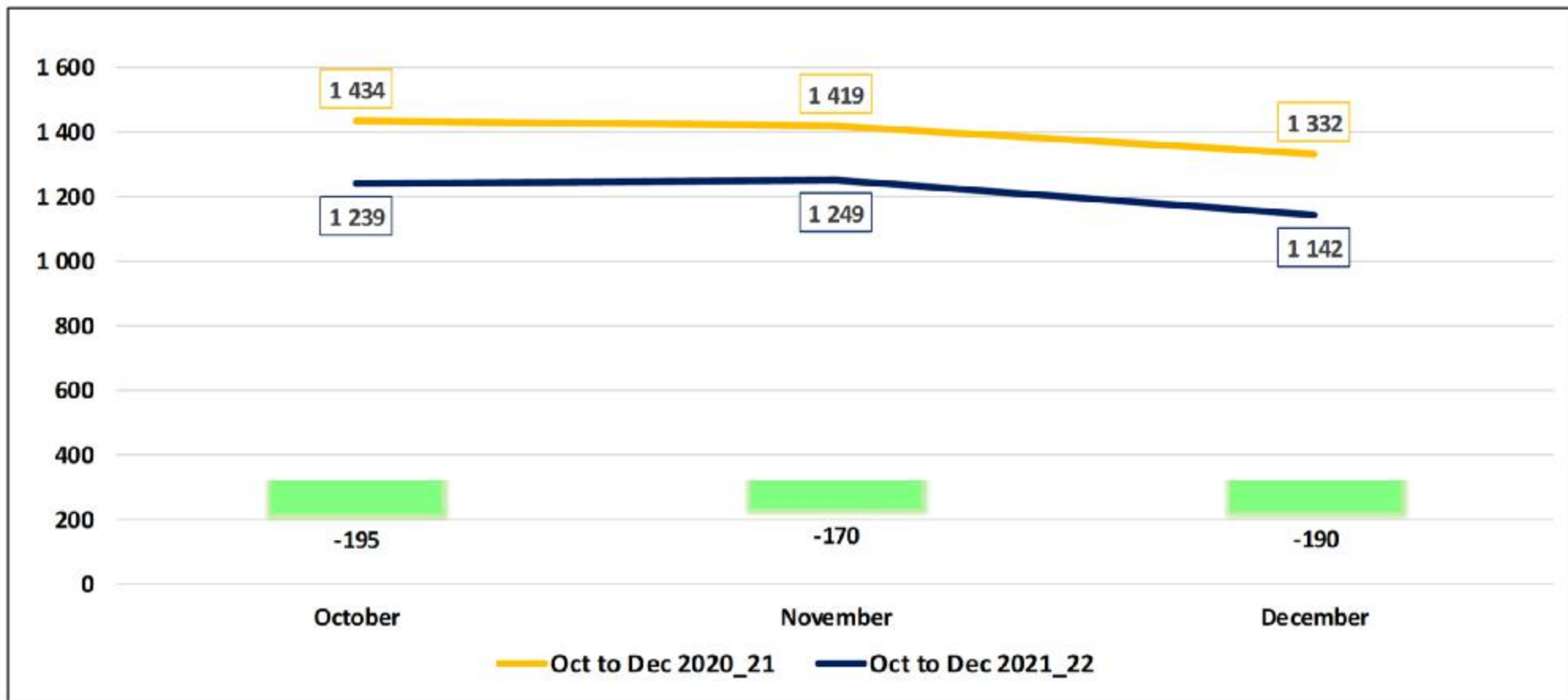

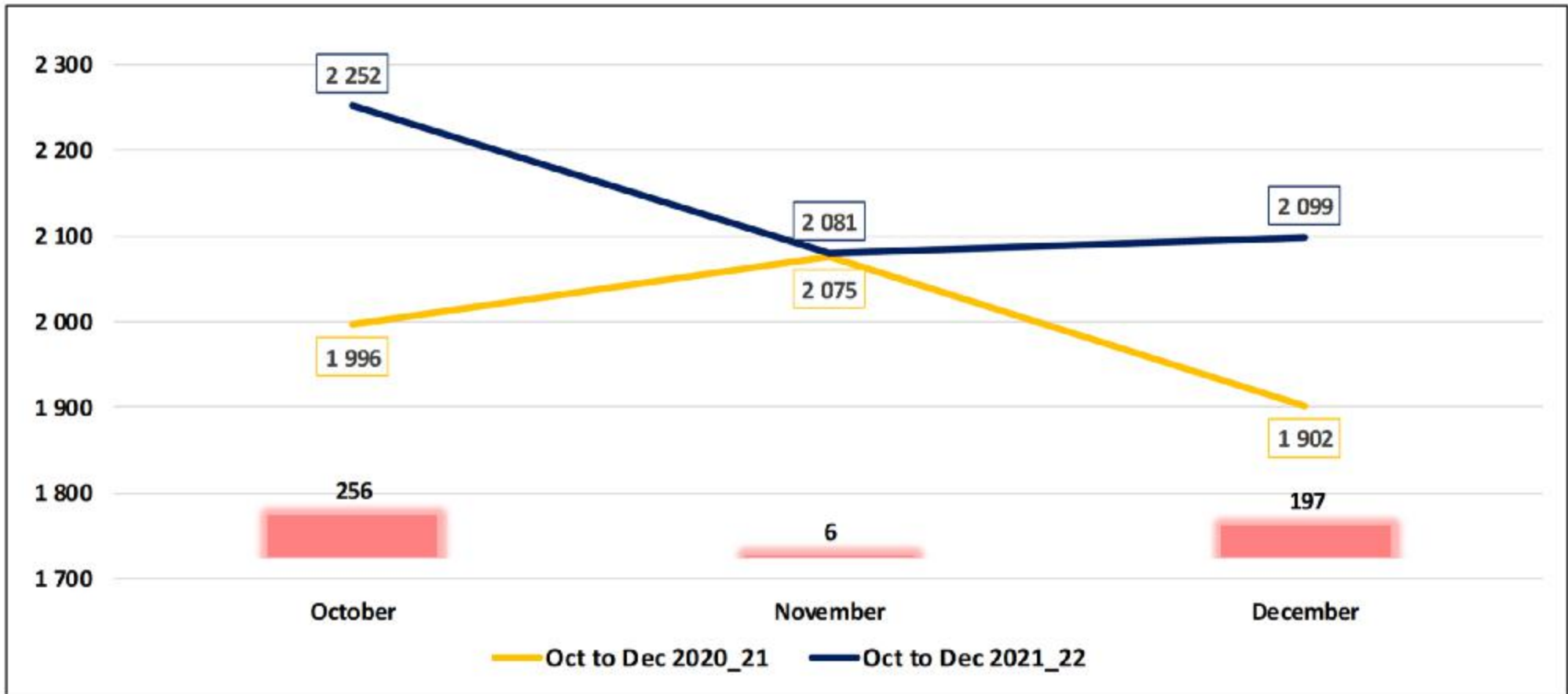

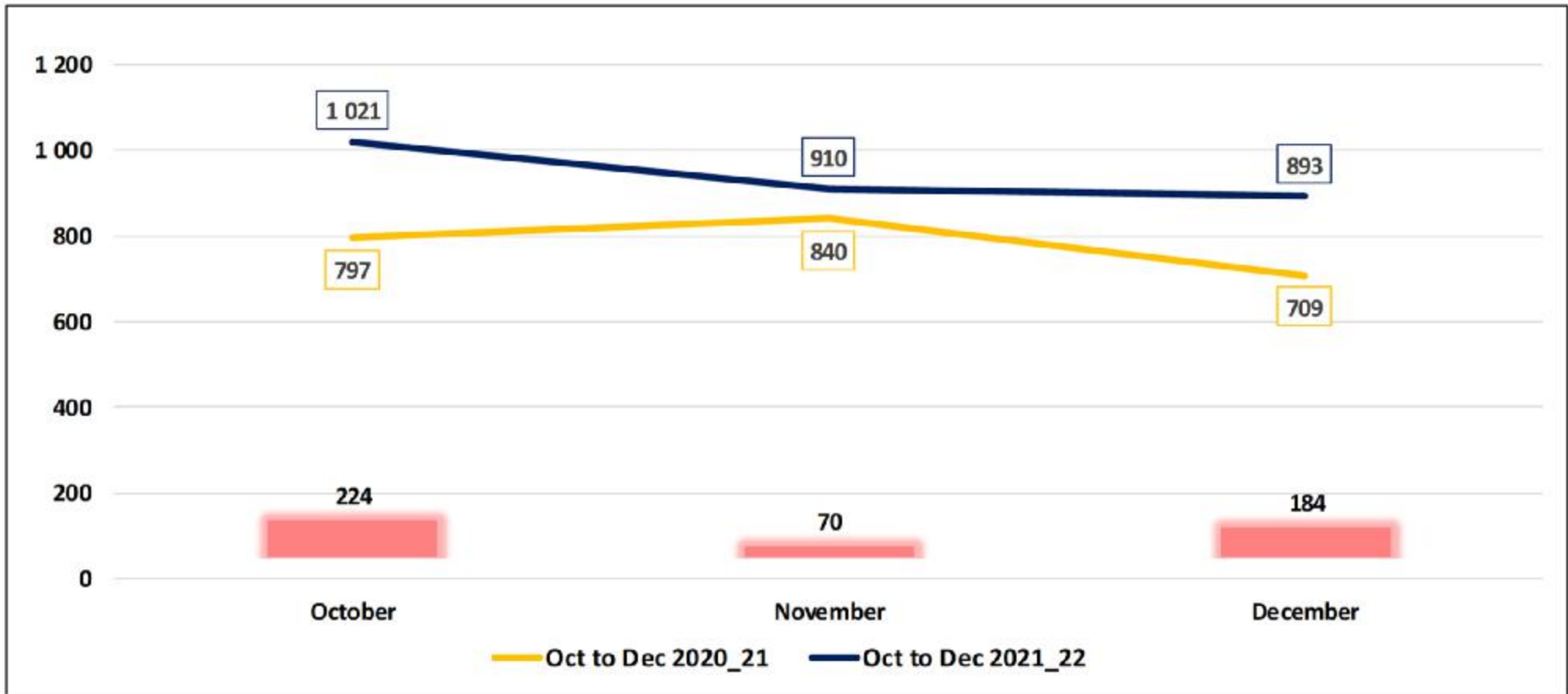

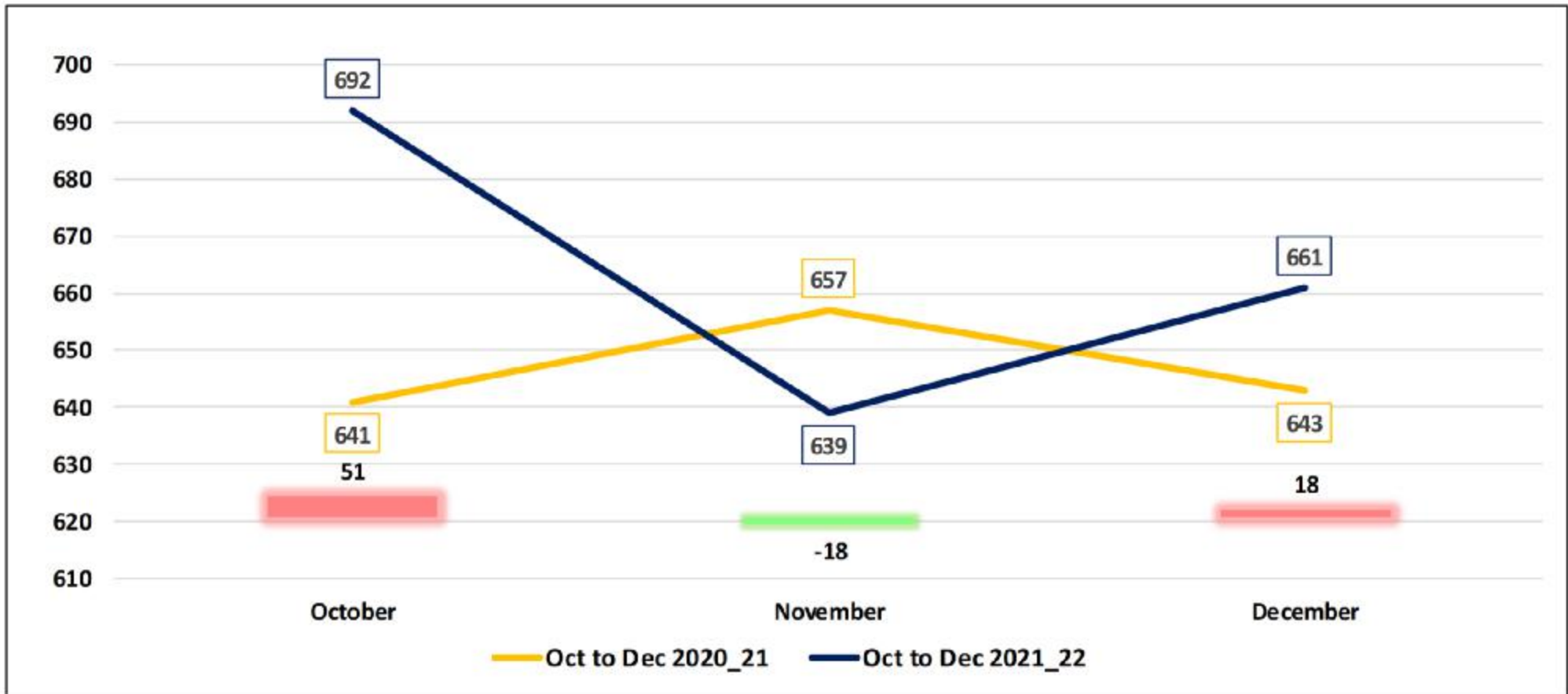

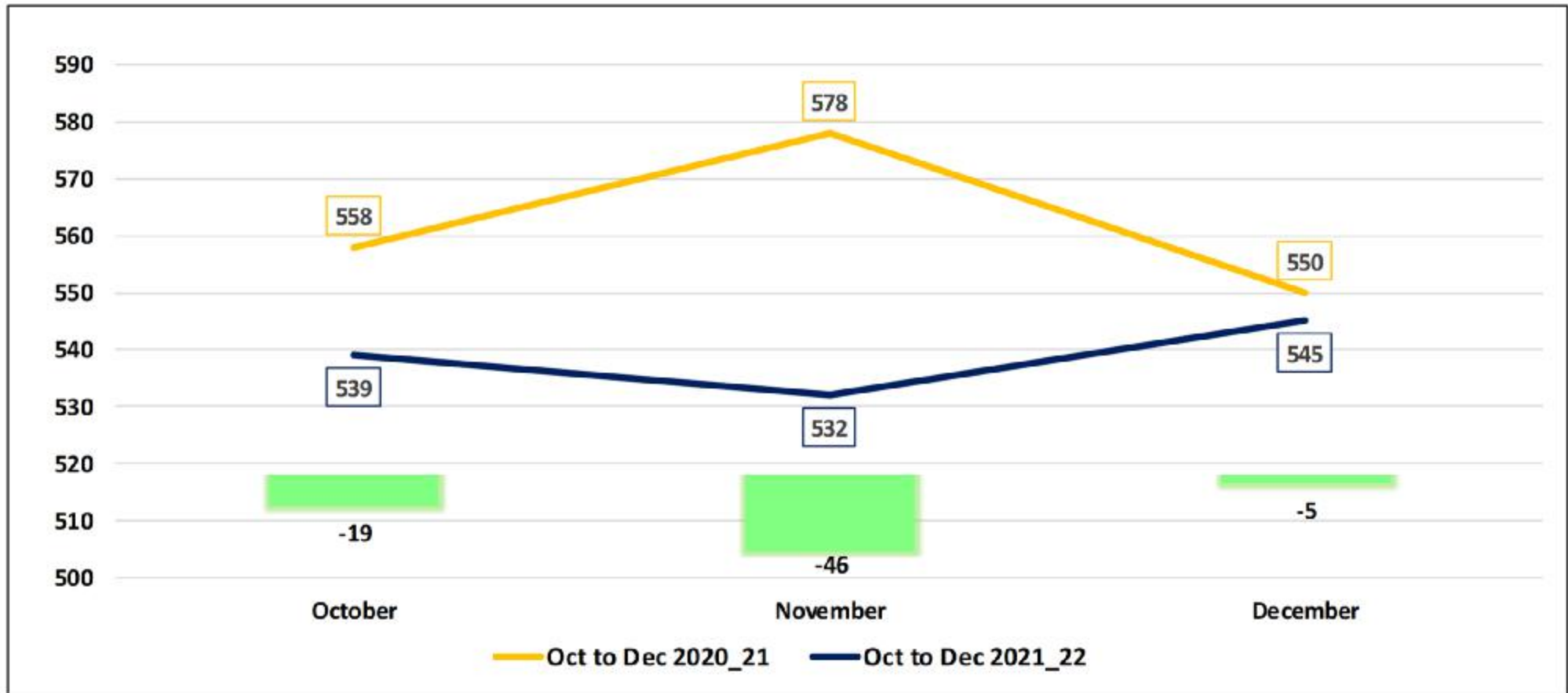

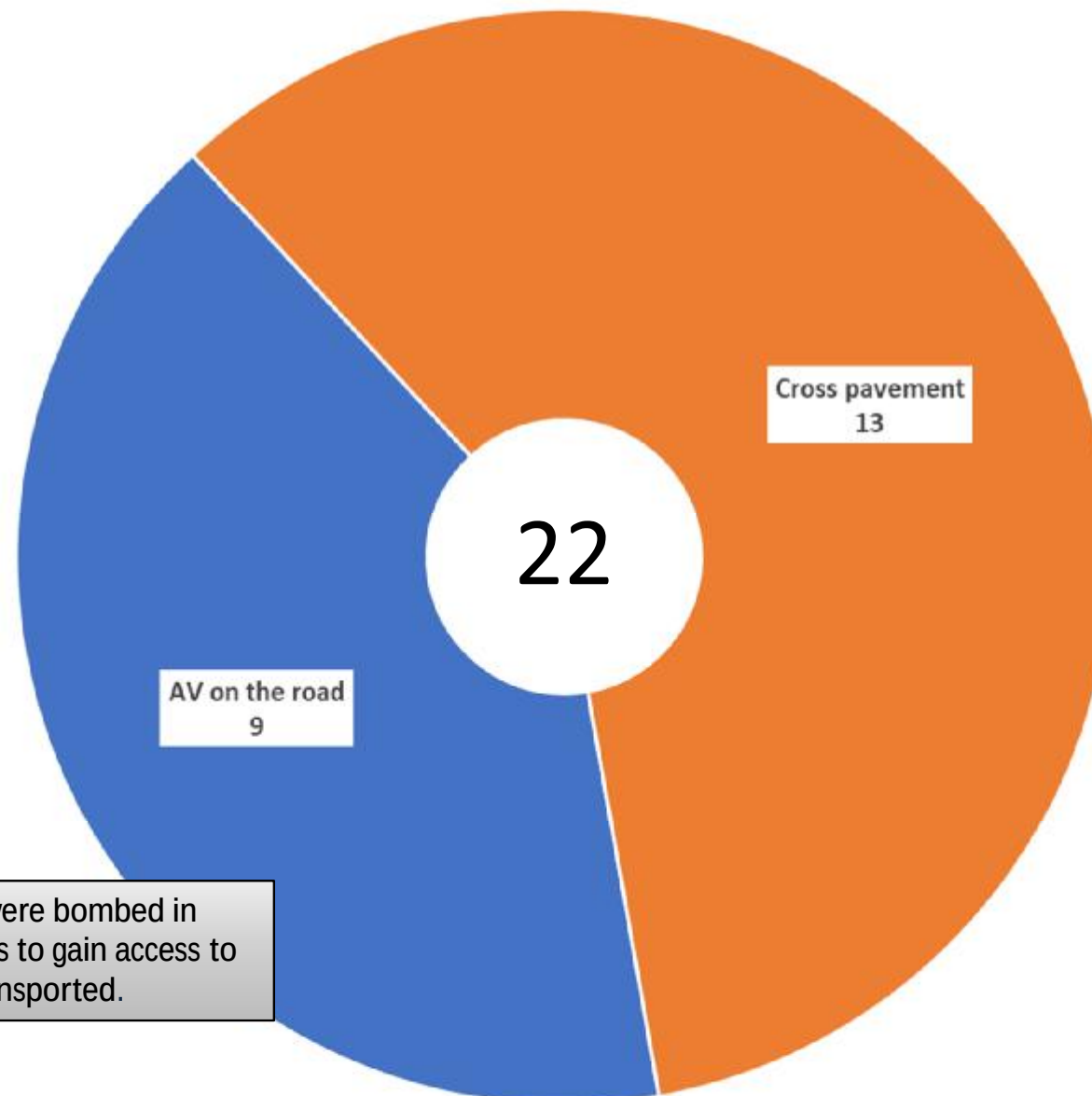

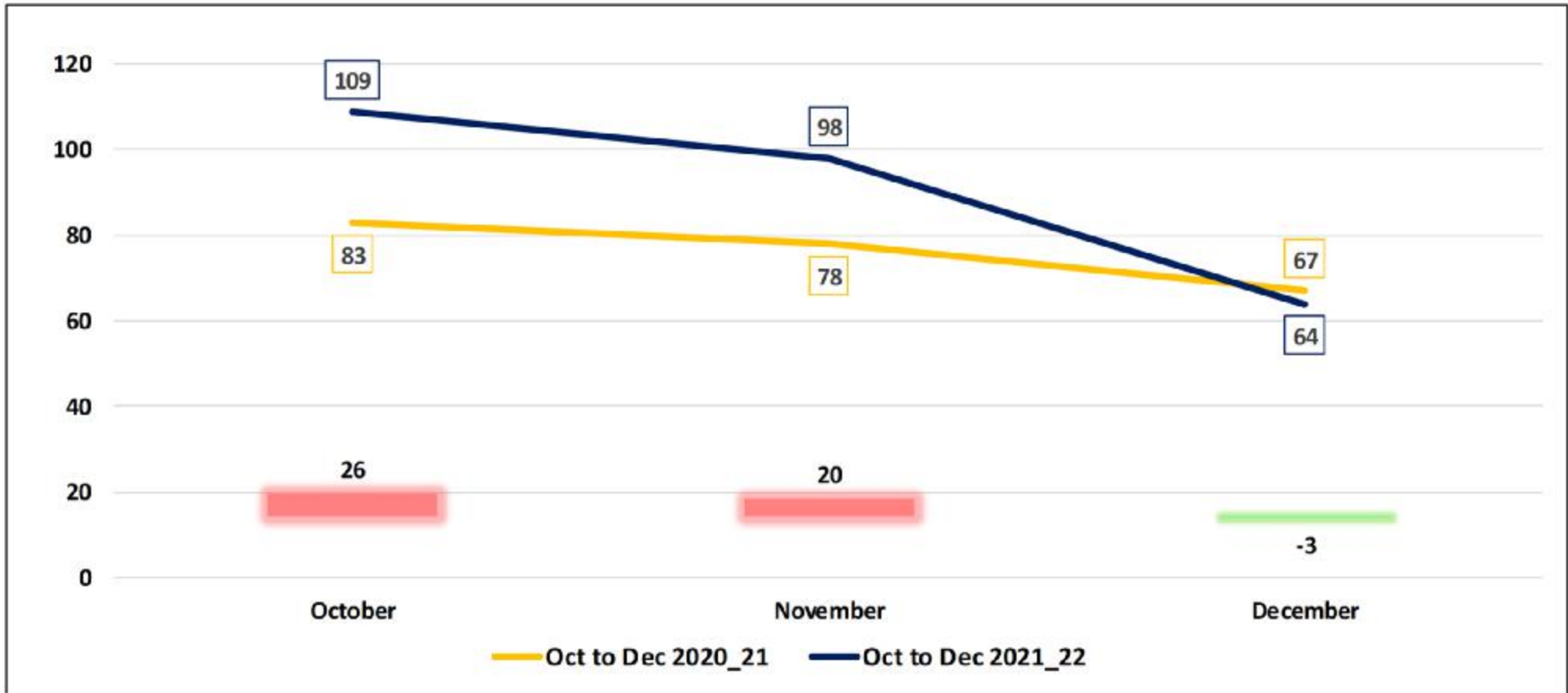

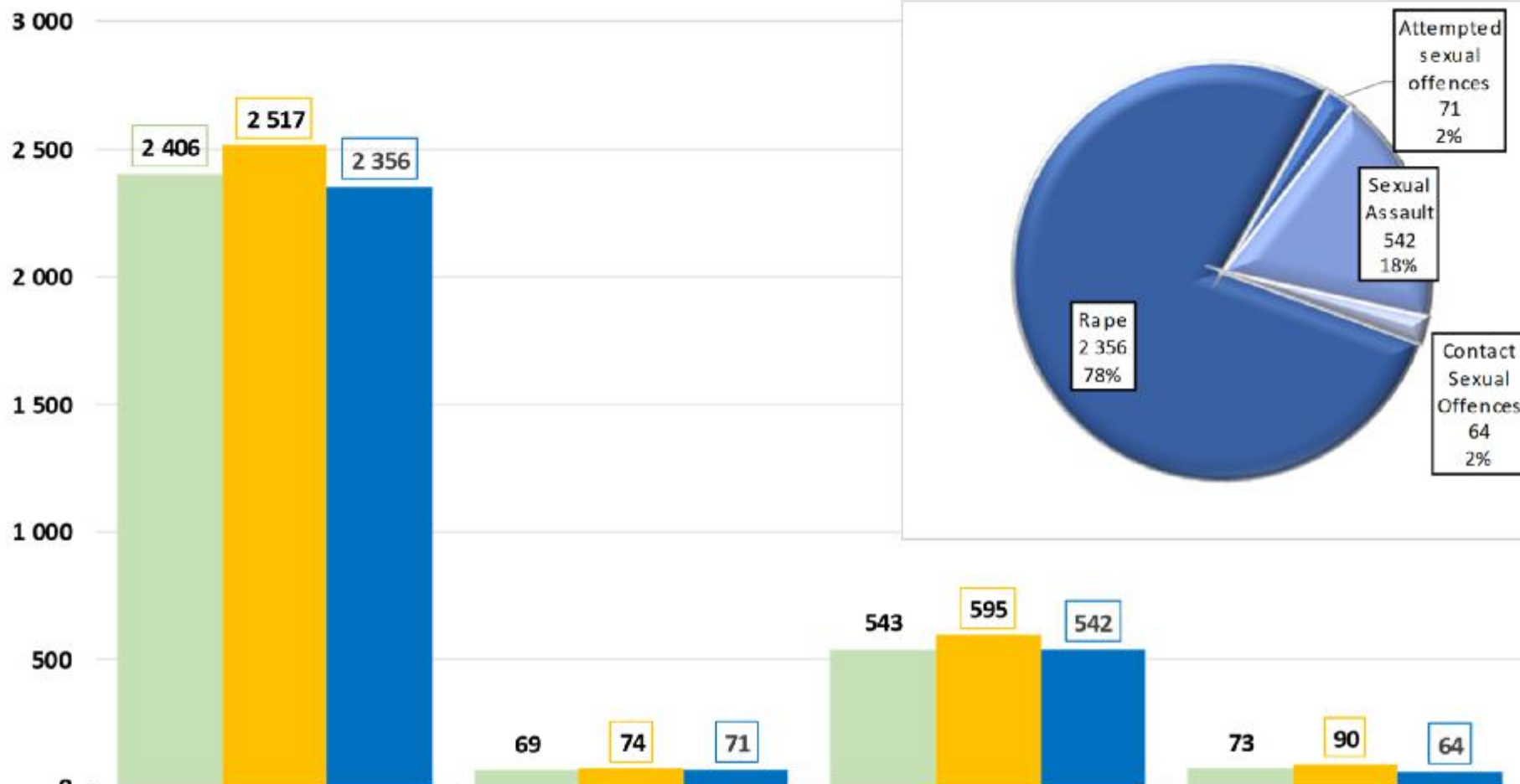

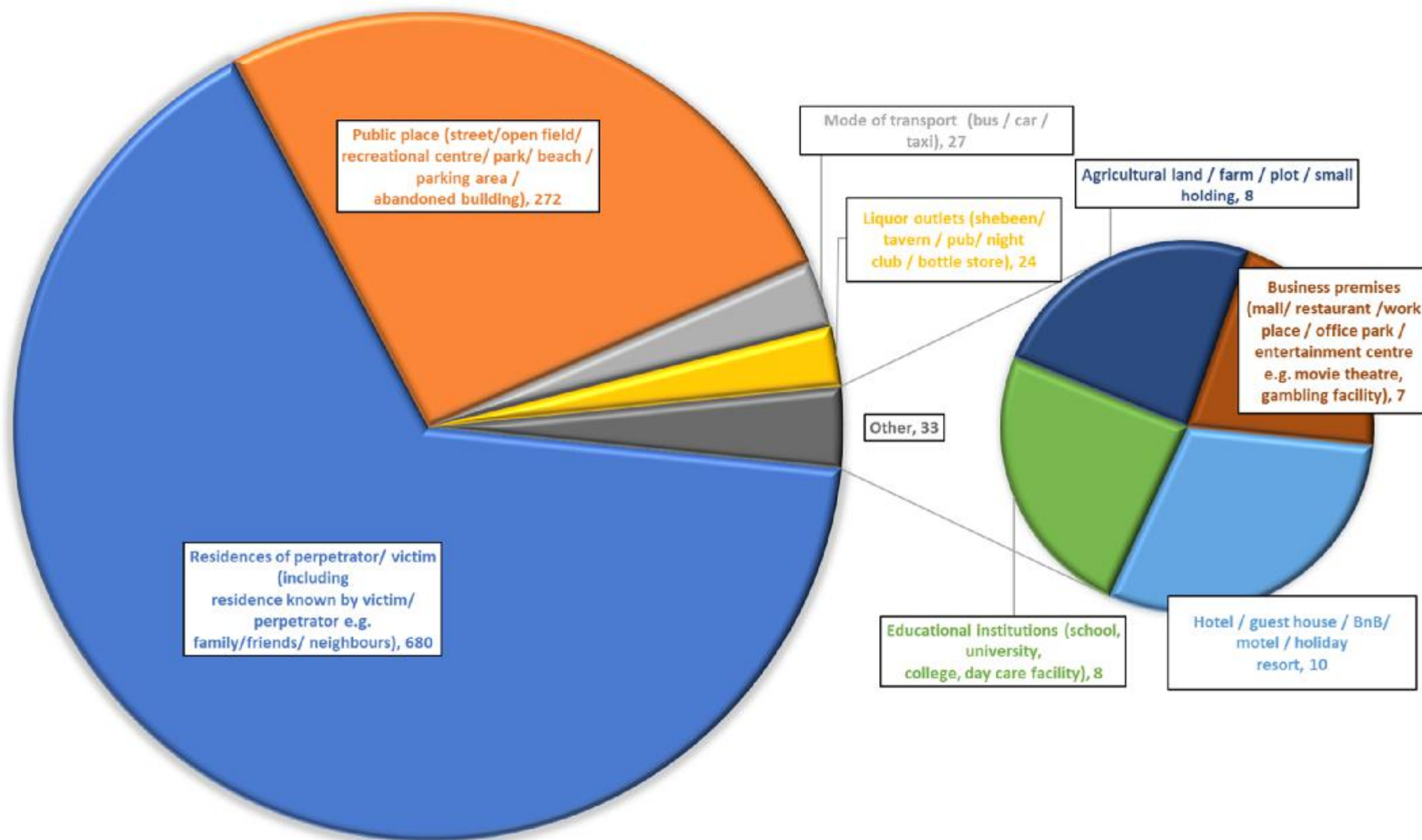

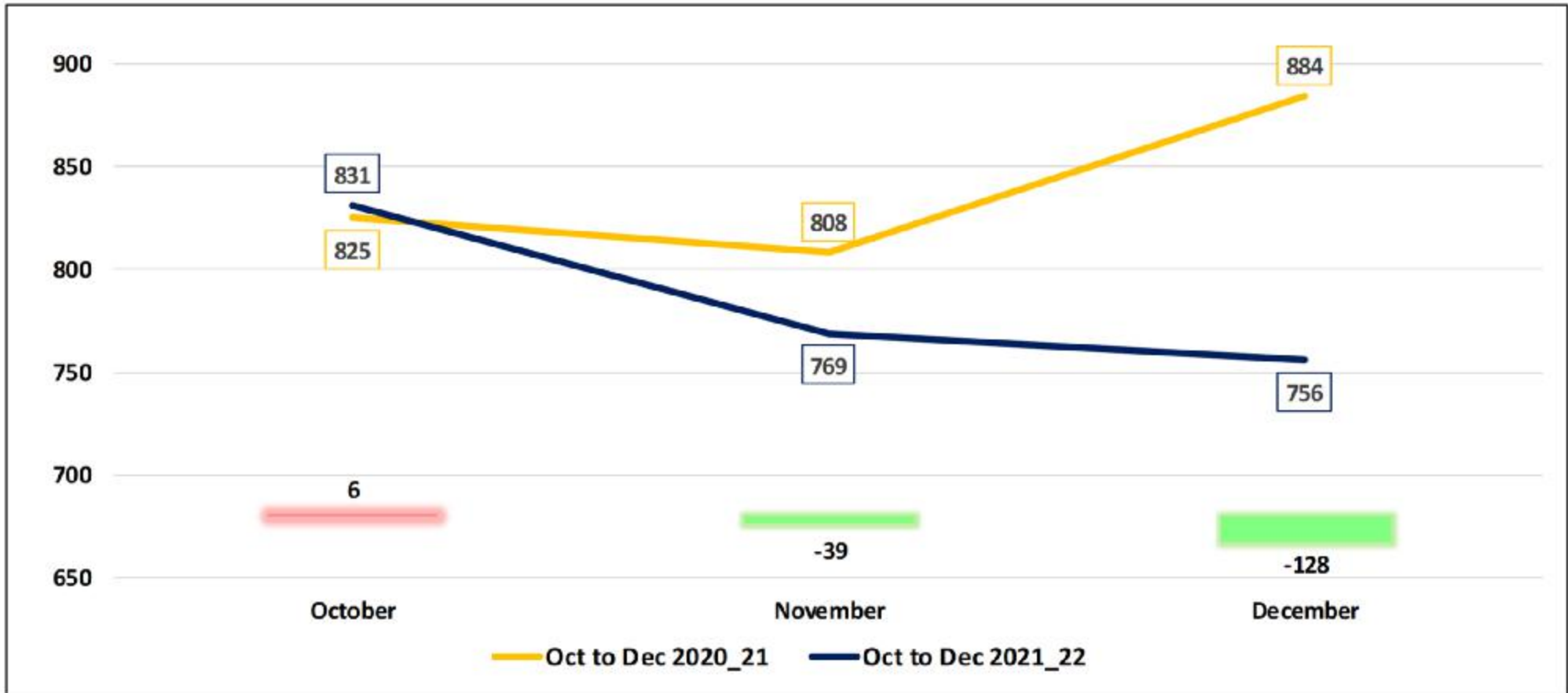

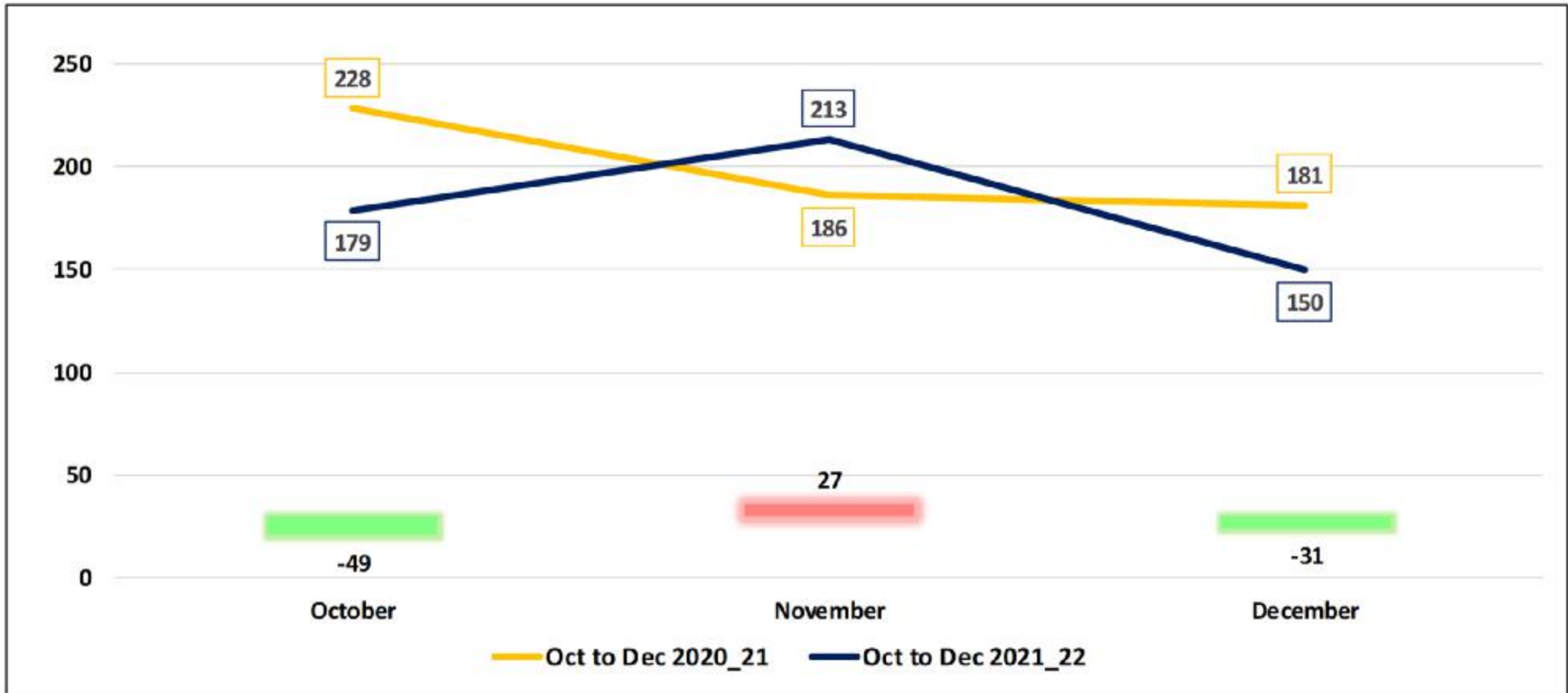

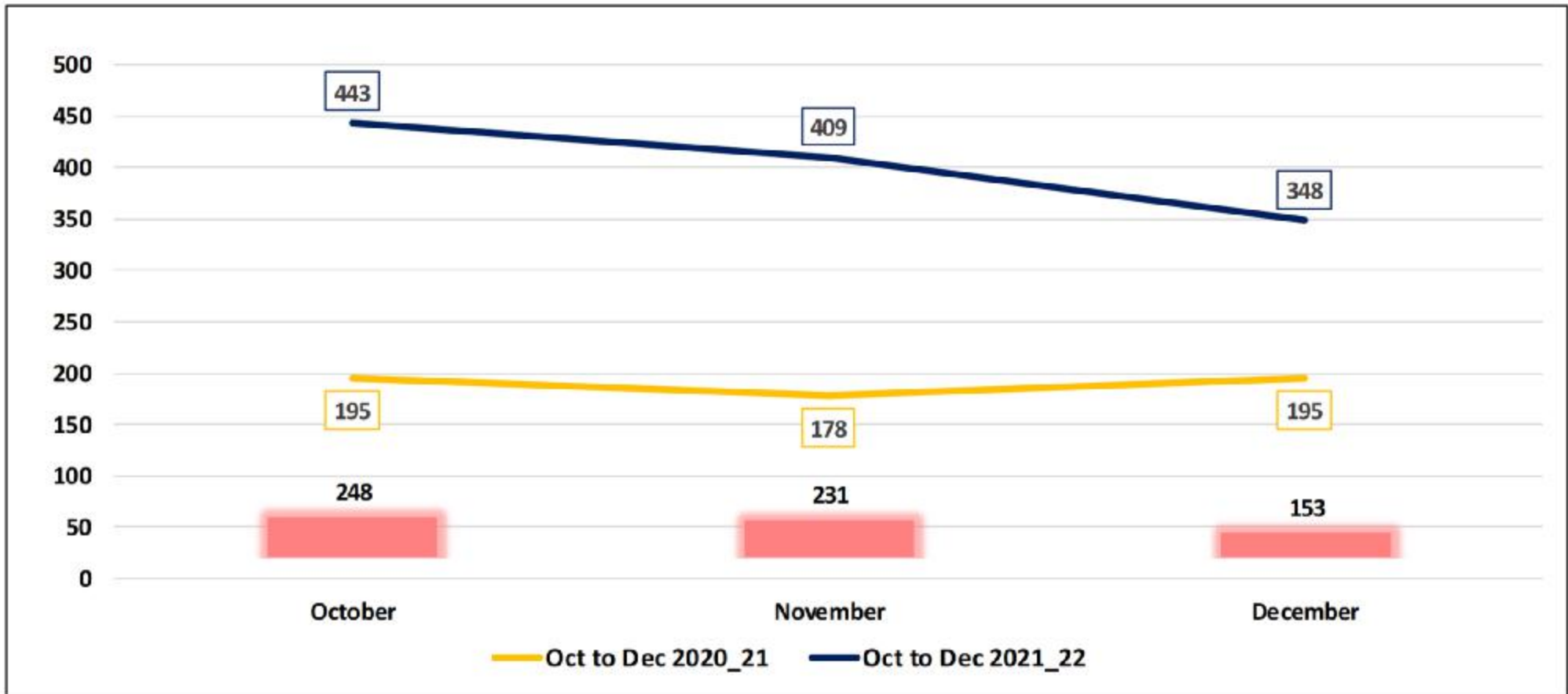

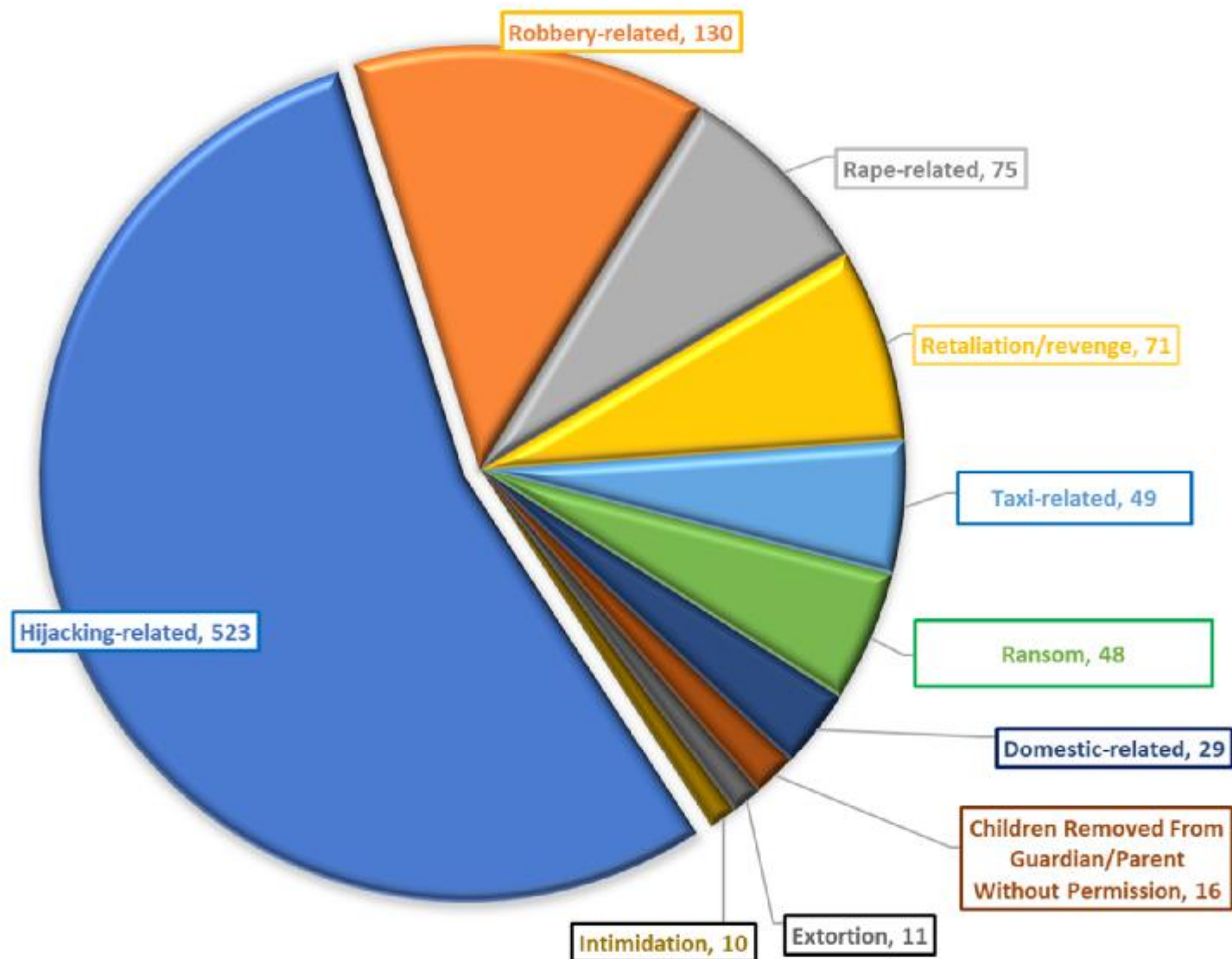

Trend per month – 2 years (District table – quarterly - 3 years)



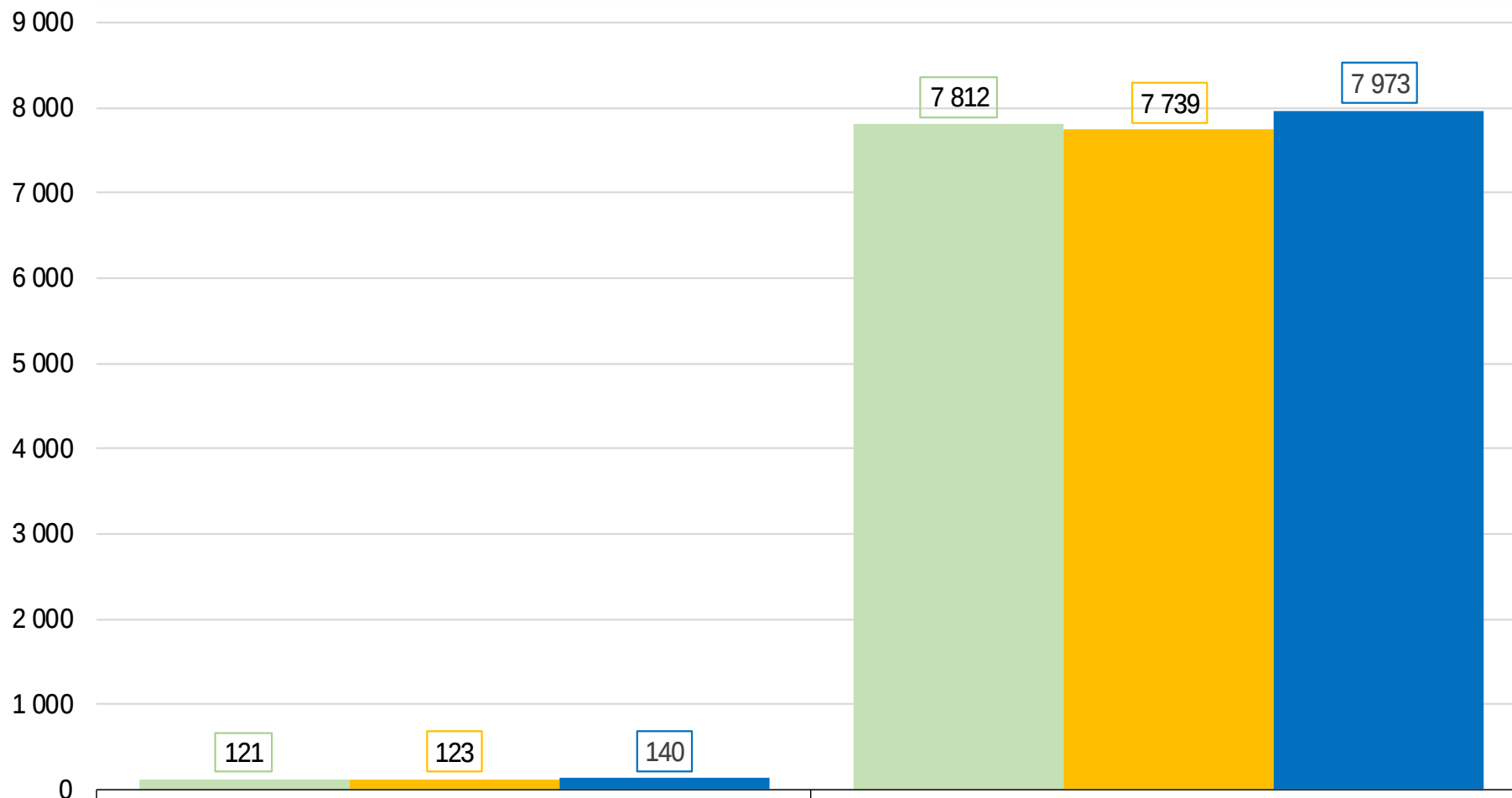

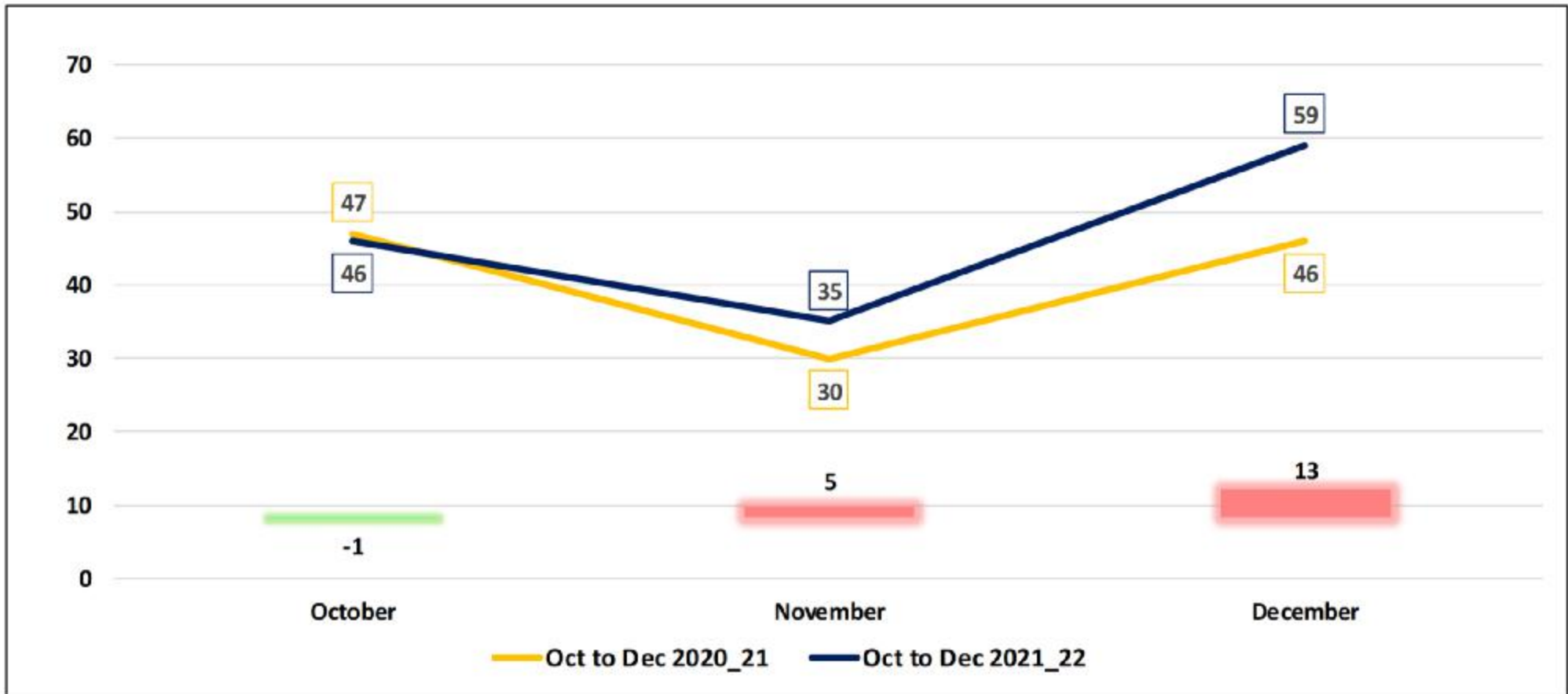

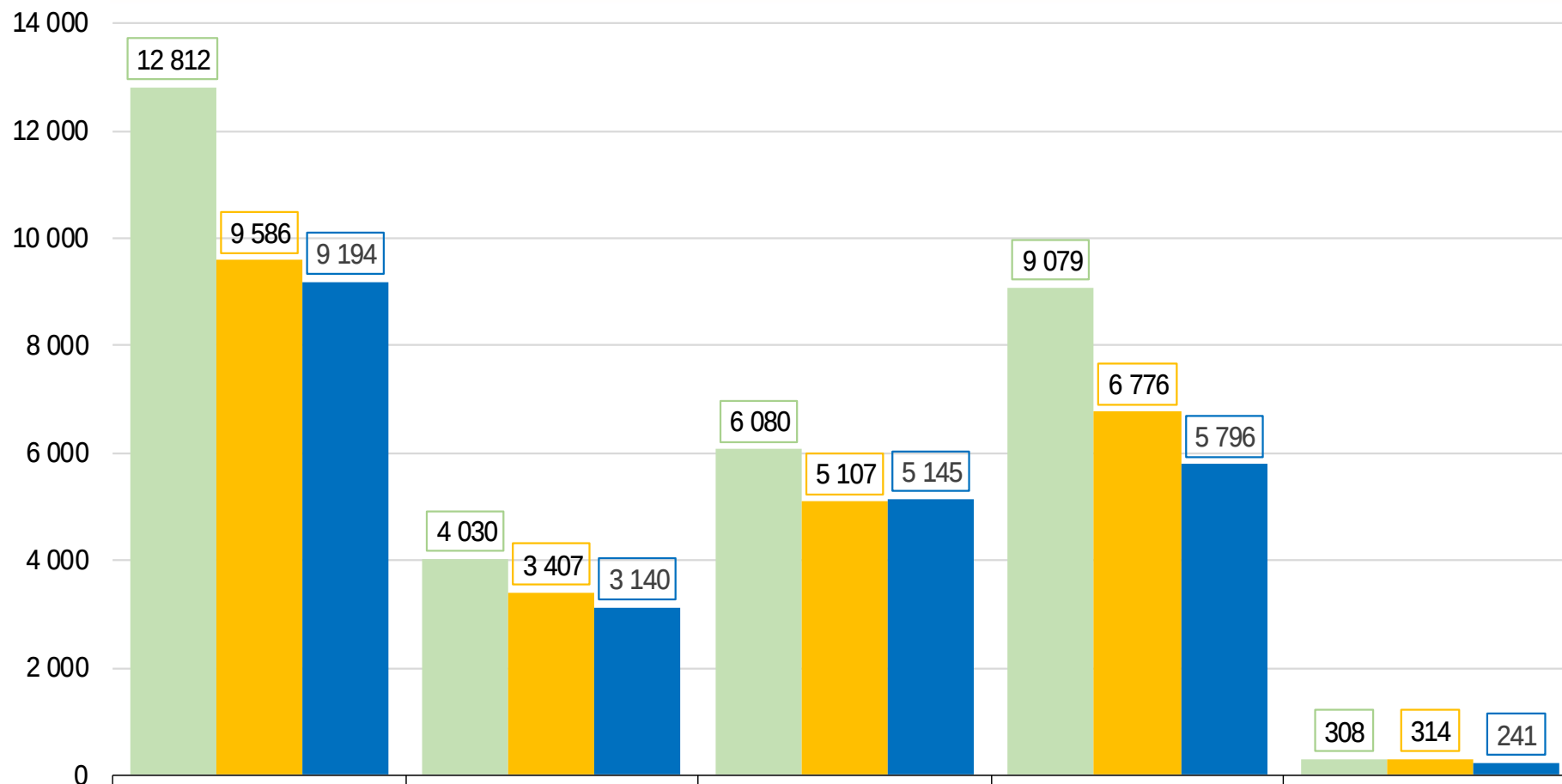

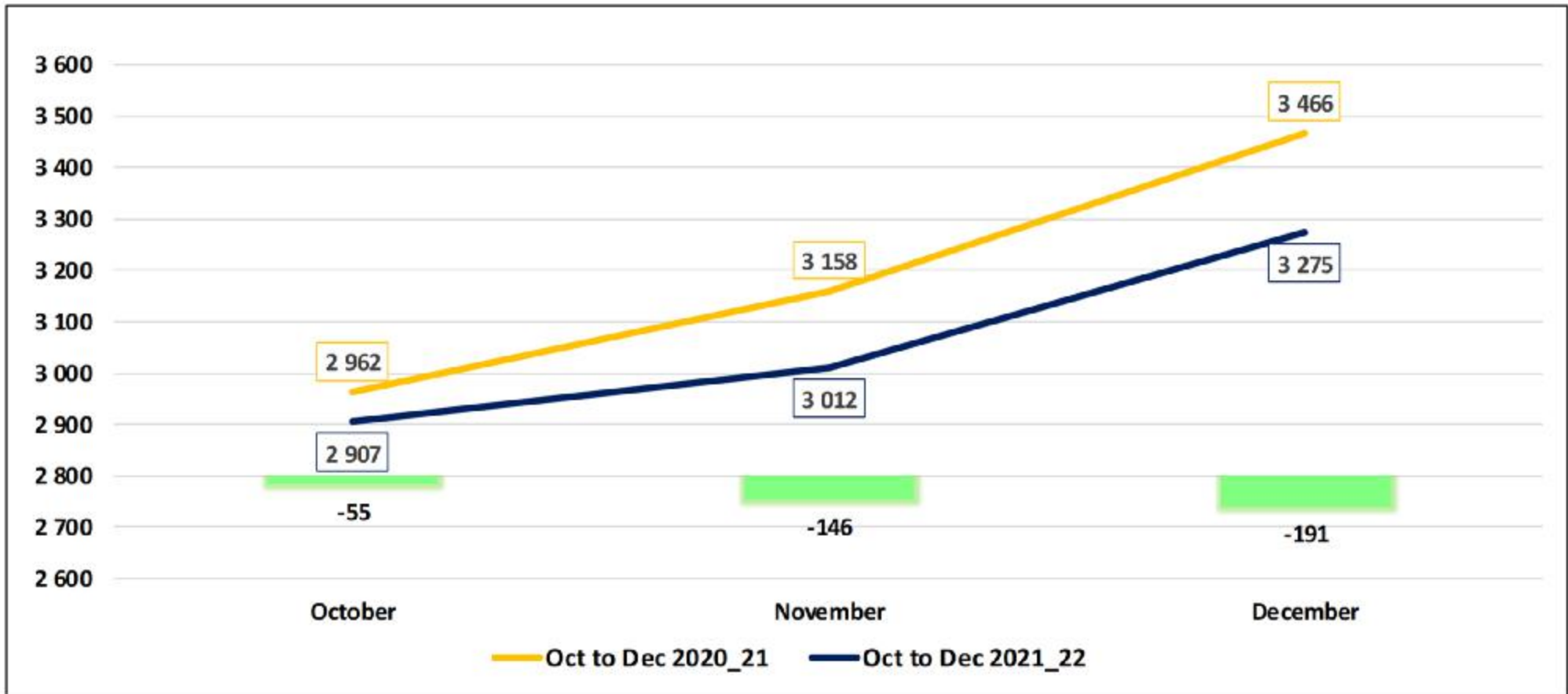

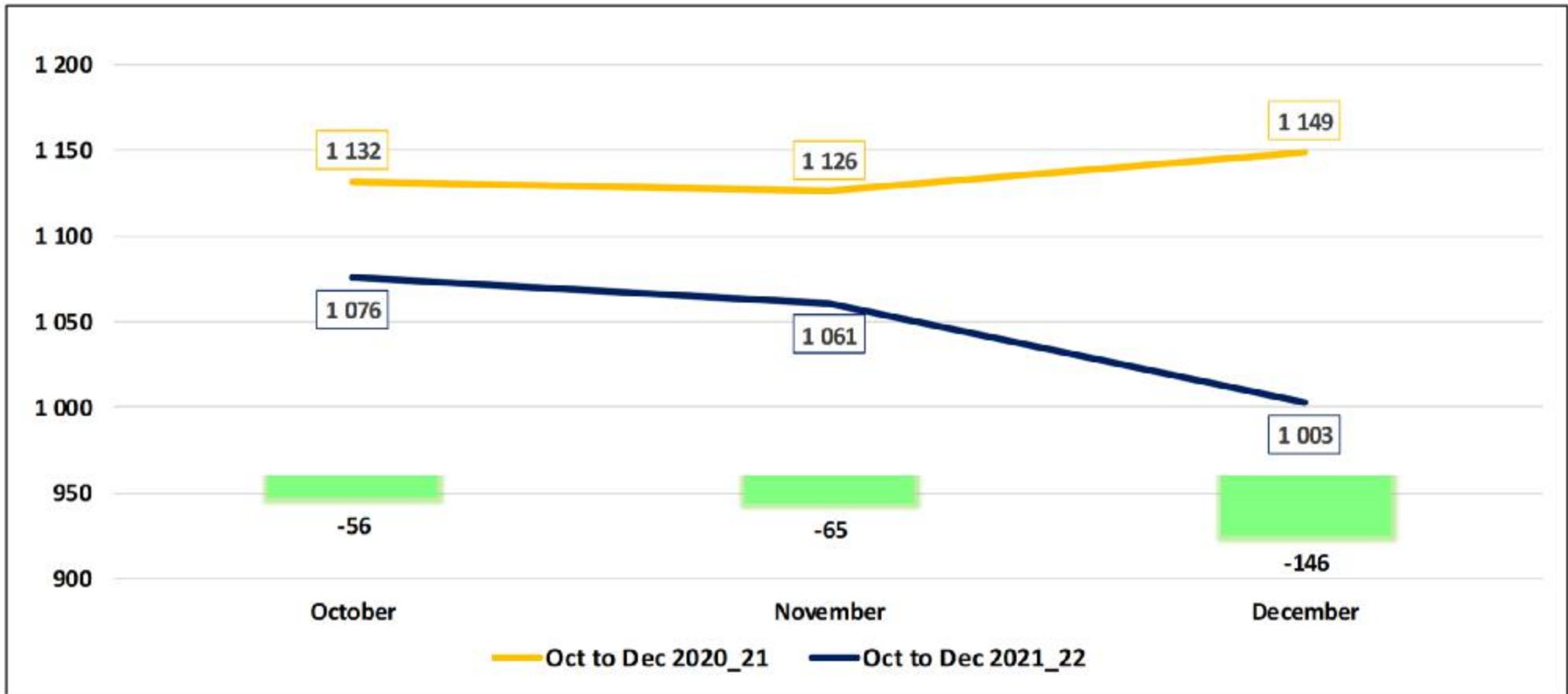

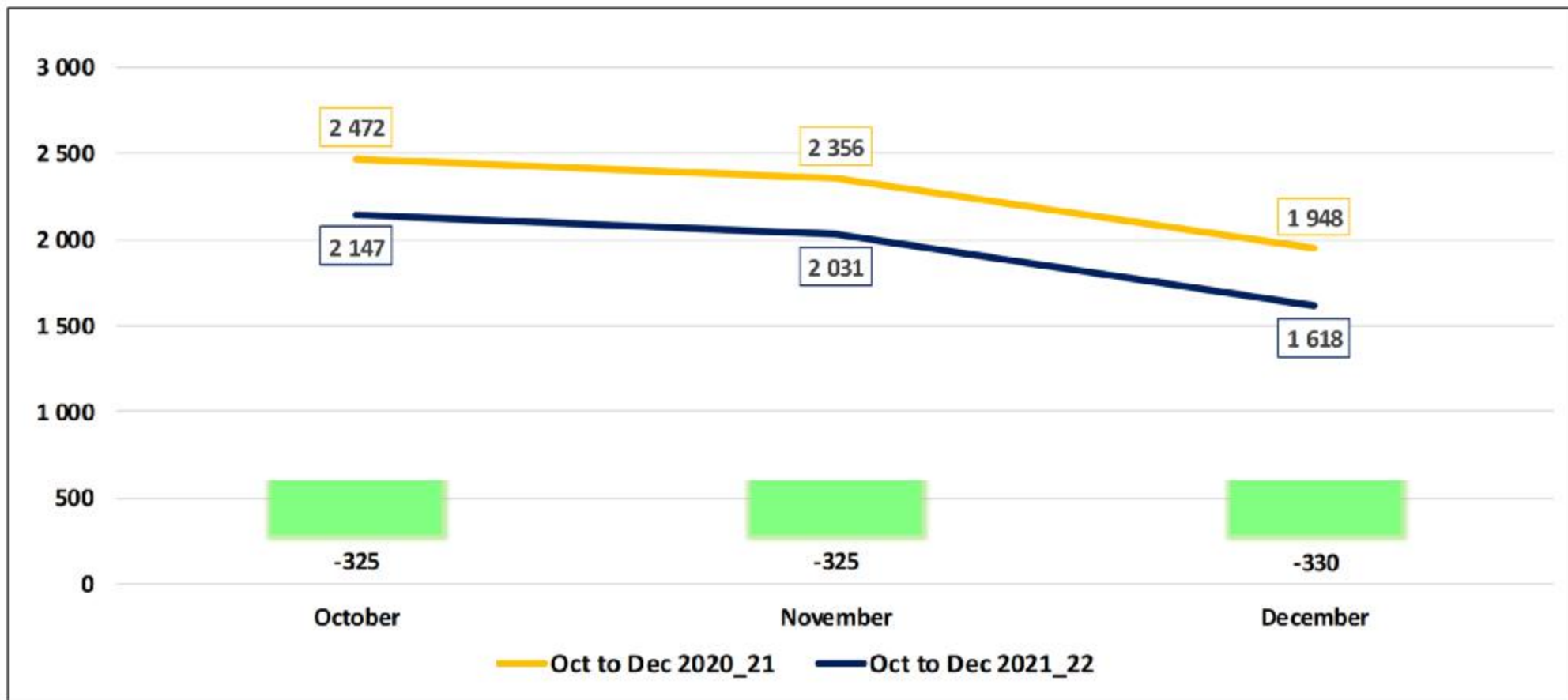

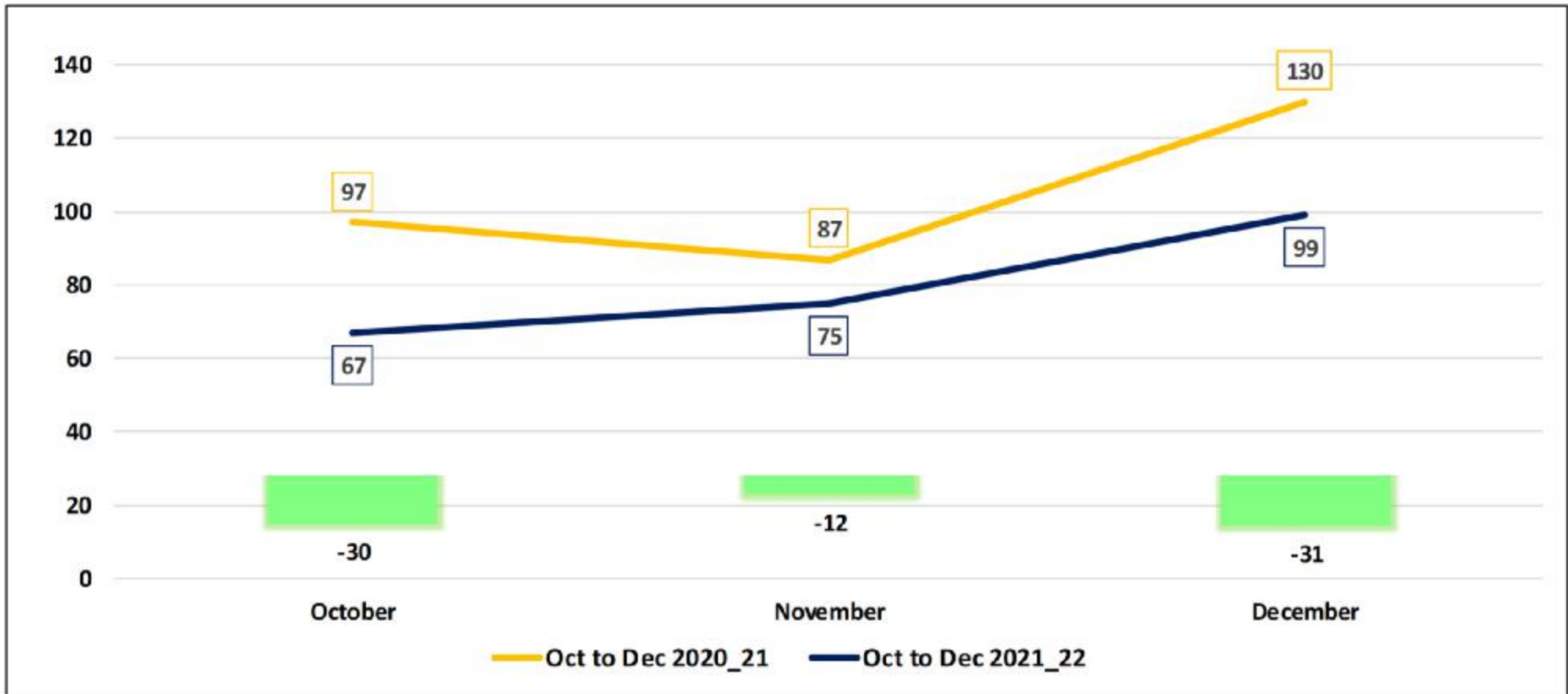

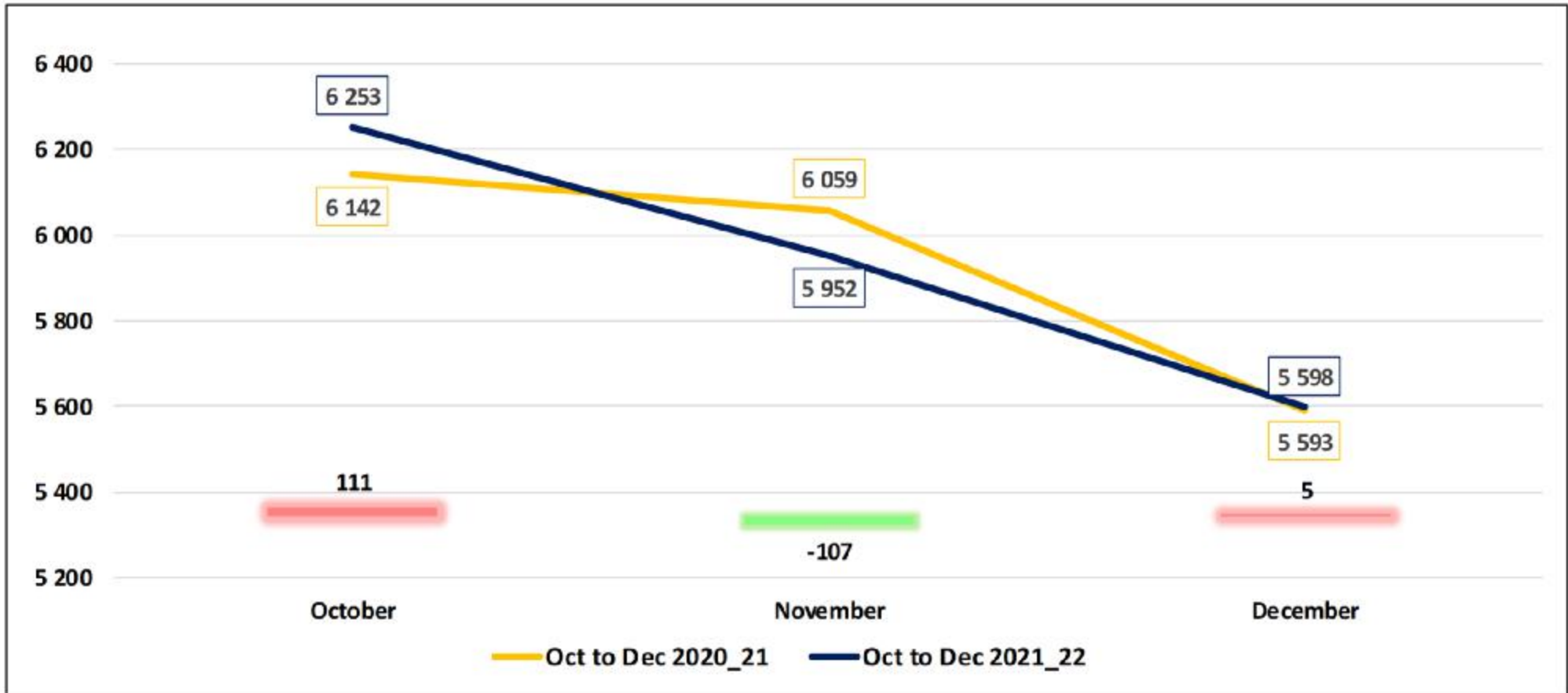

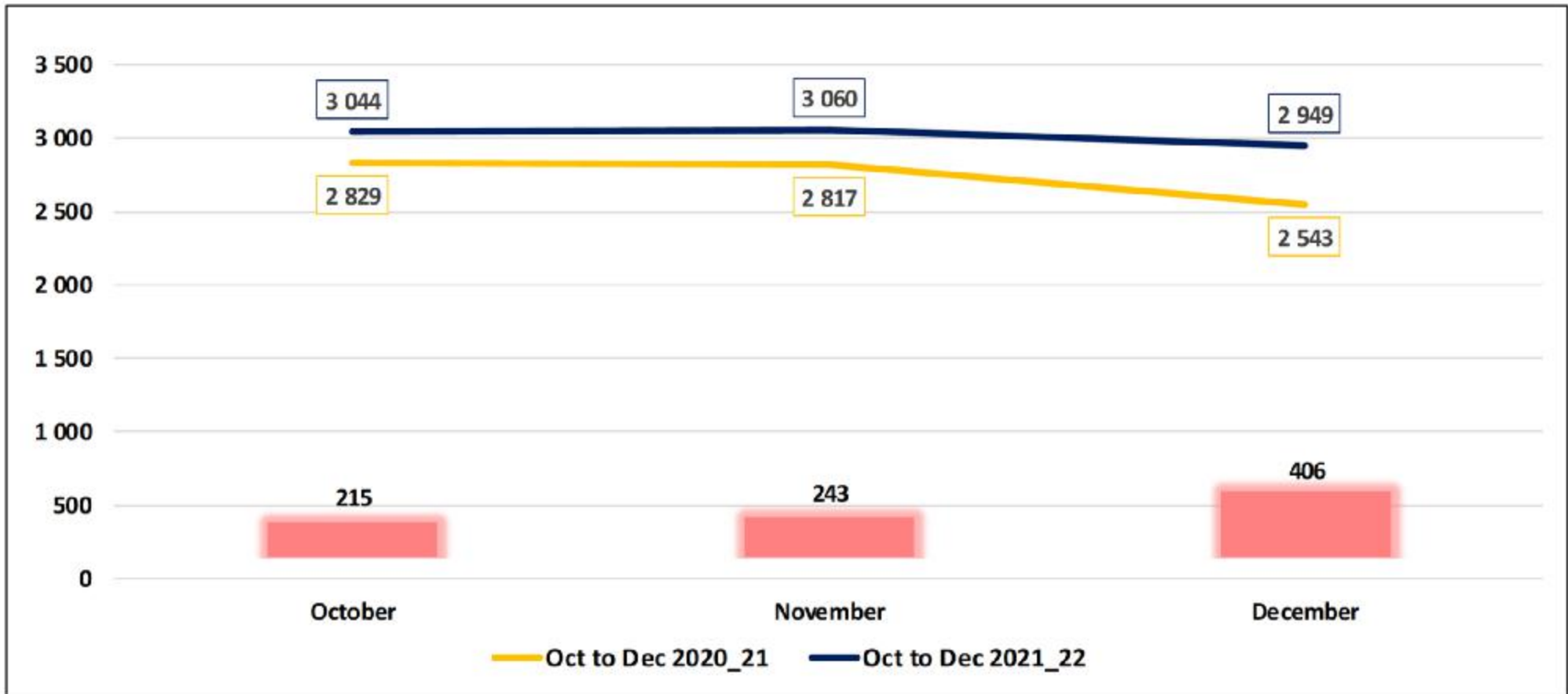

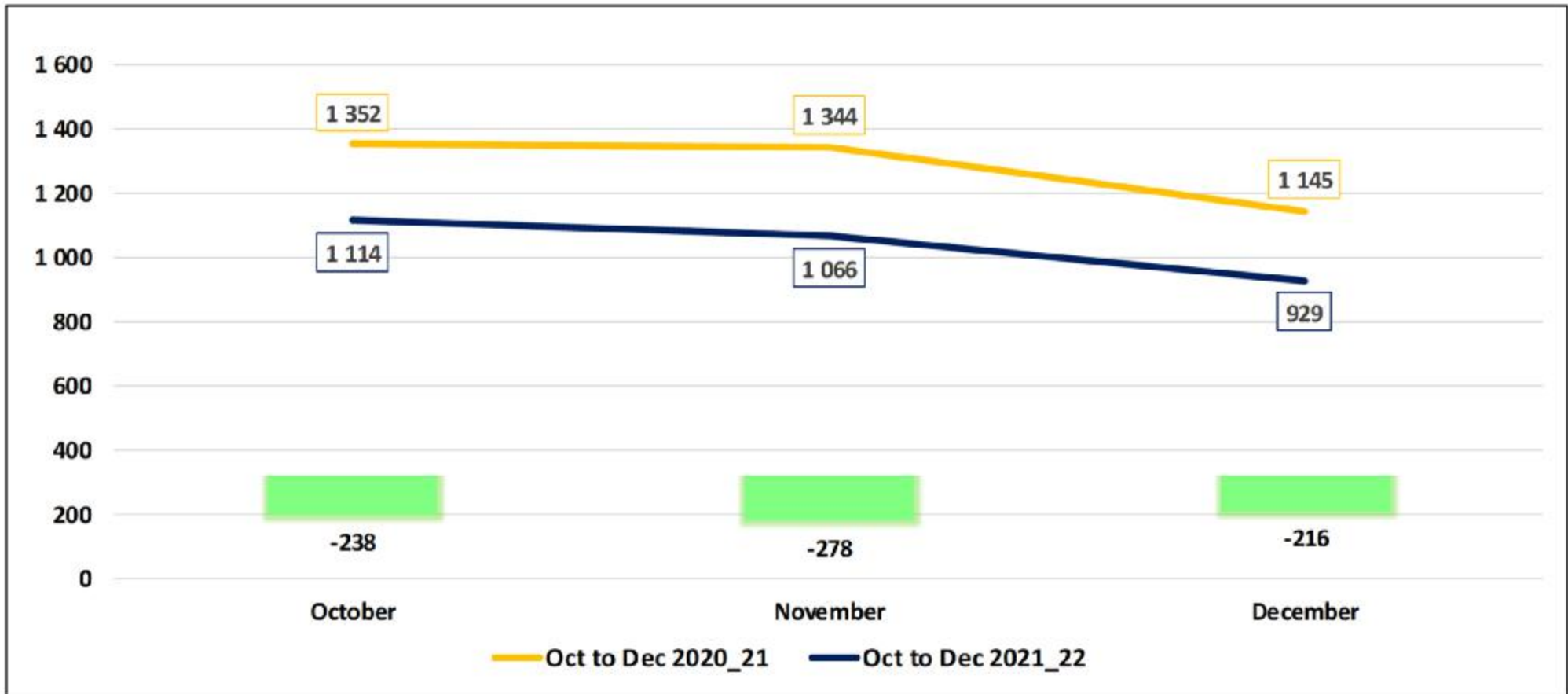

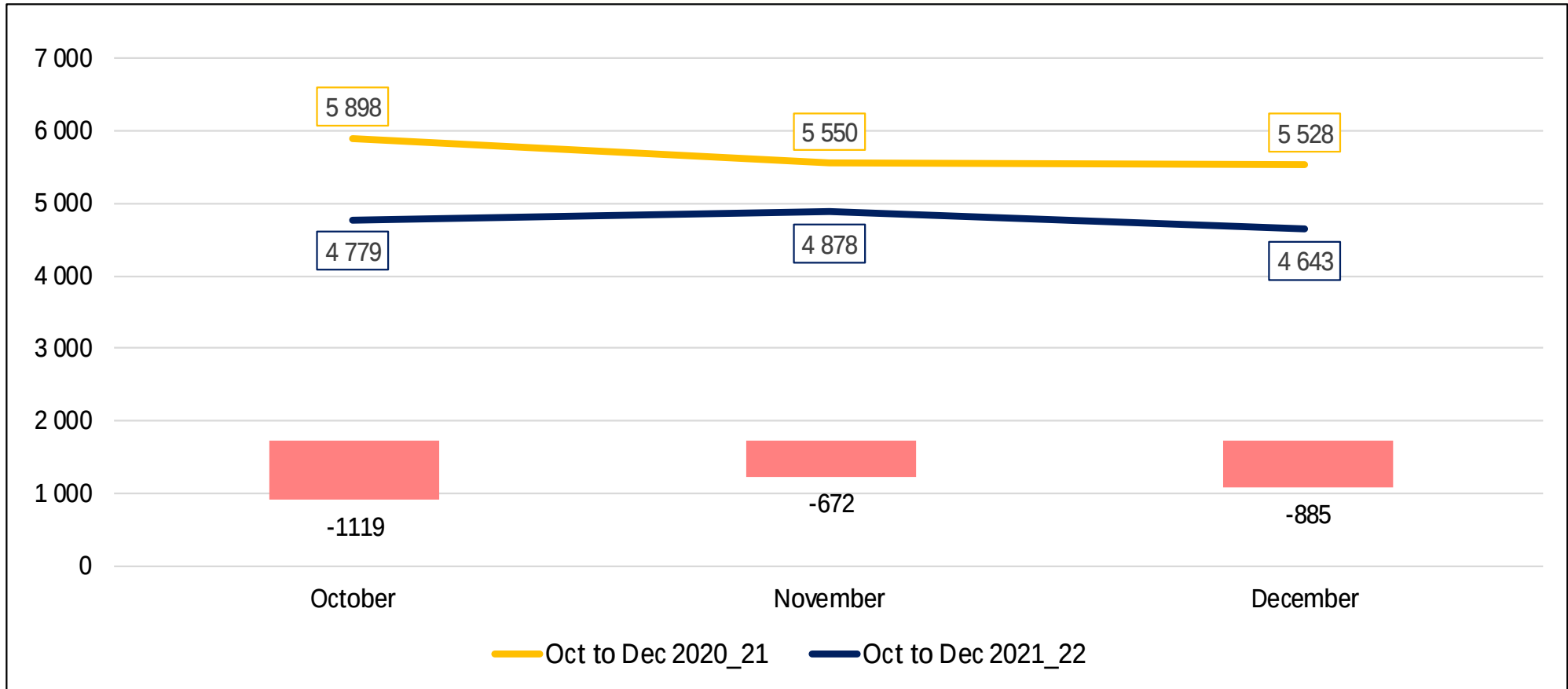

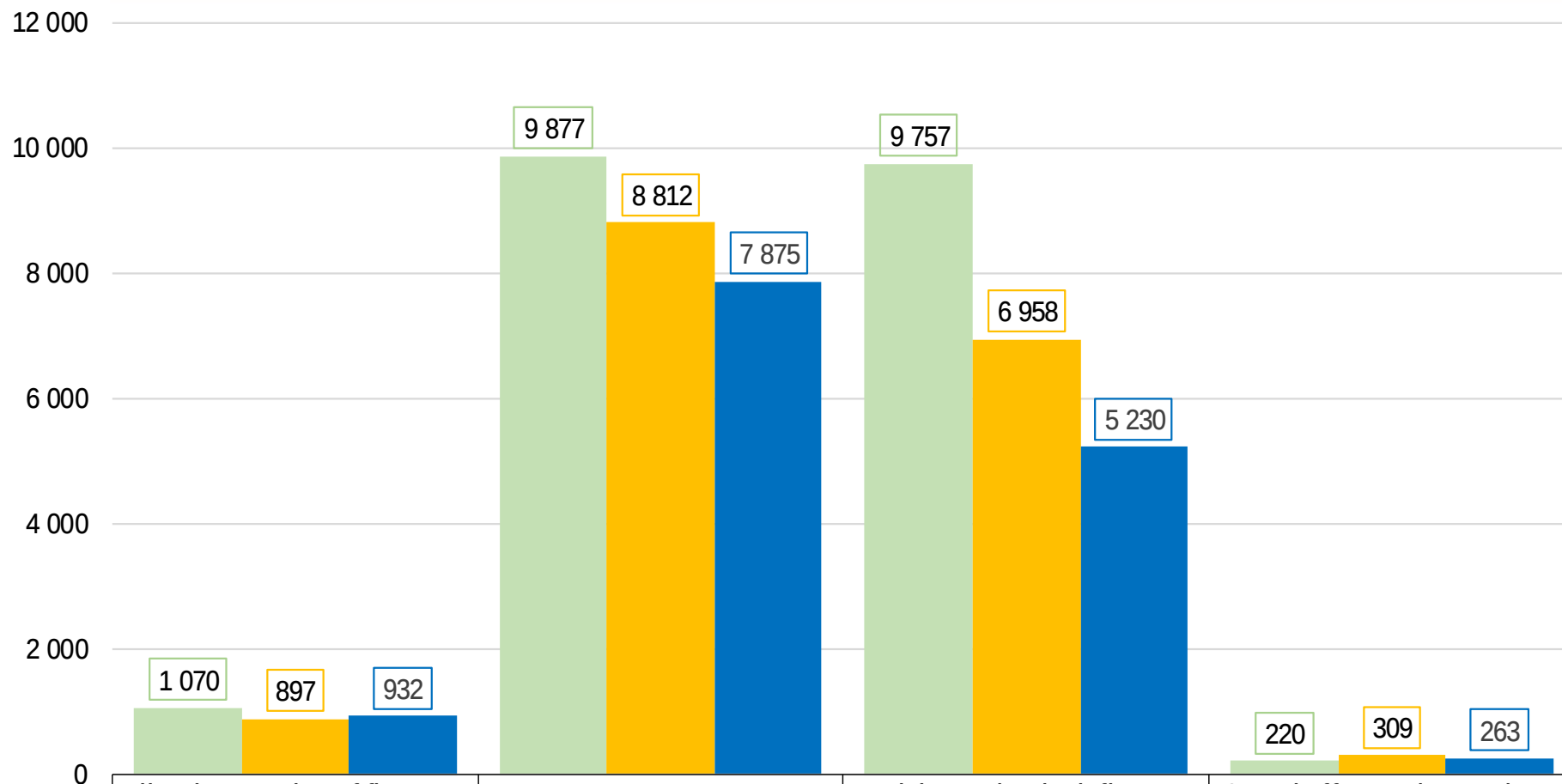

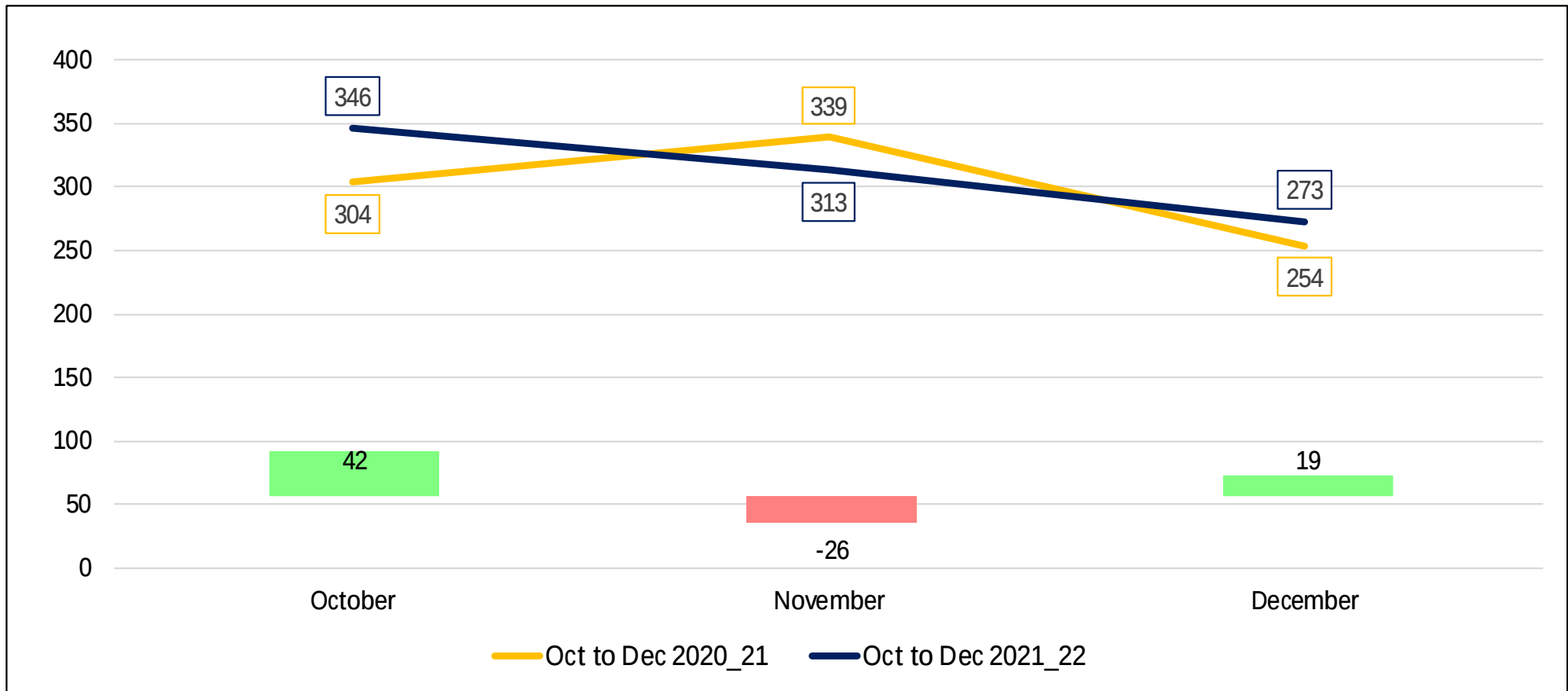
SUB CATEGORIES OF CRIME DETECTED AS A RESULT OF POLICE ACTION

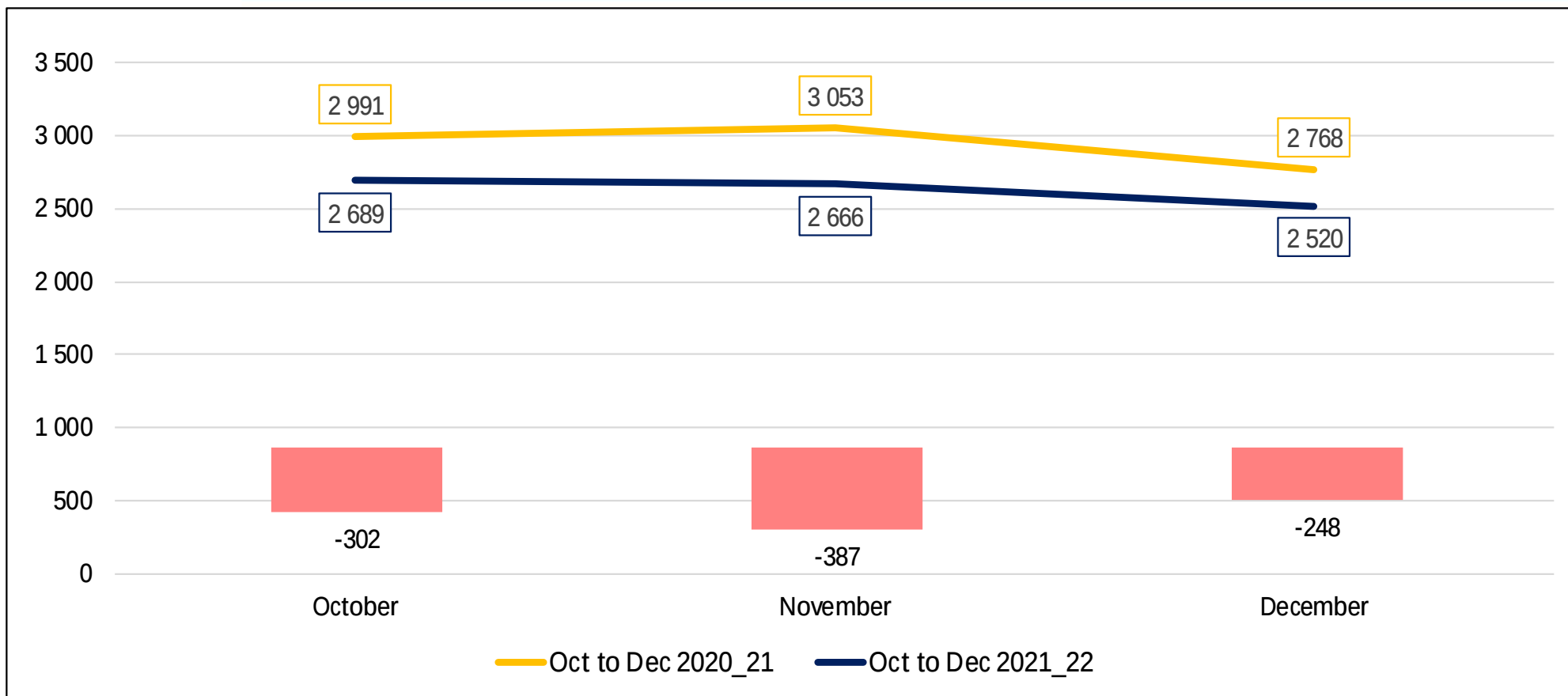

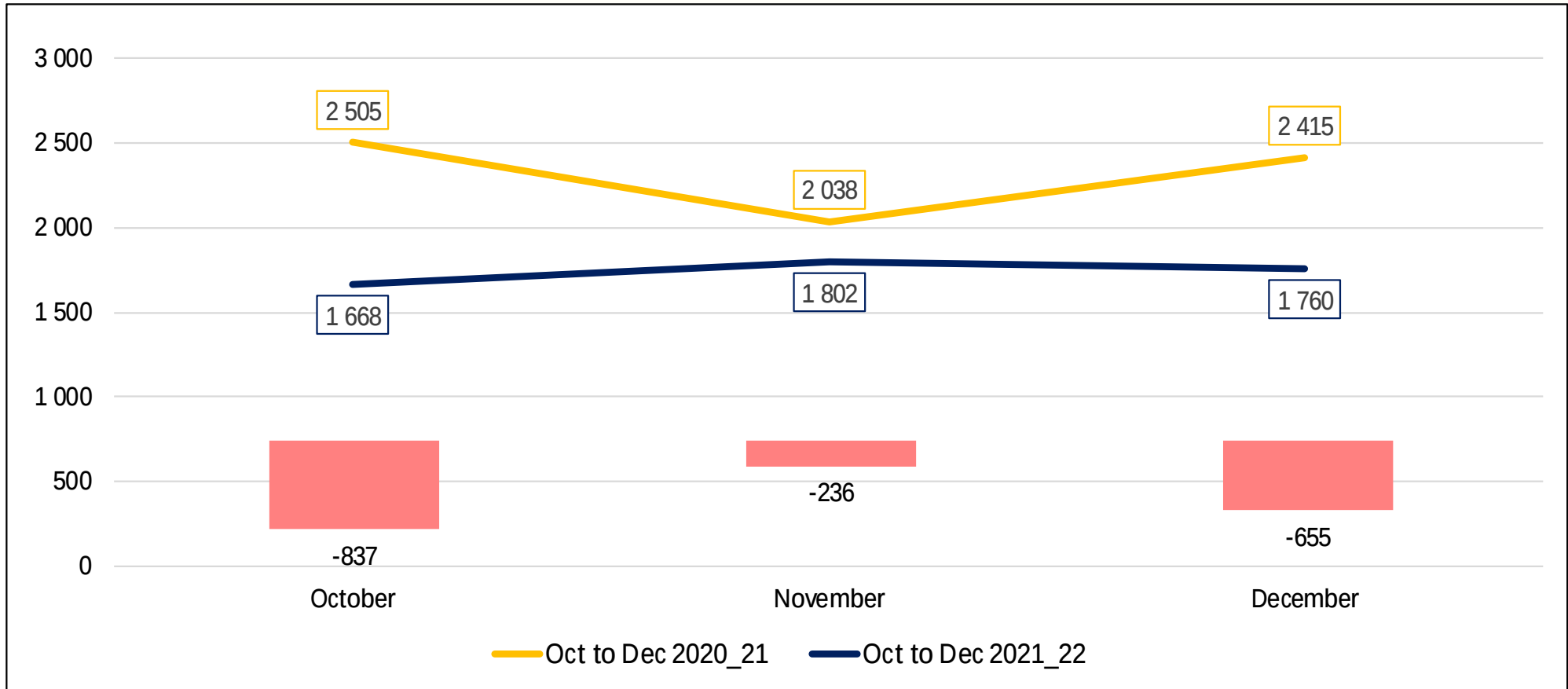

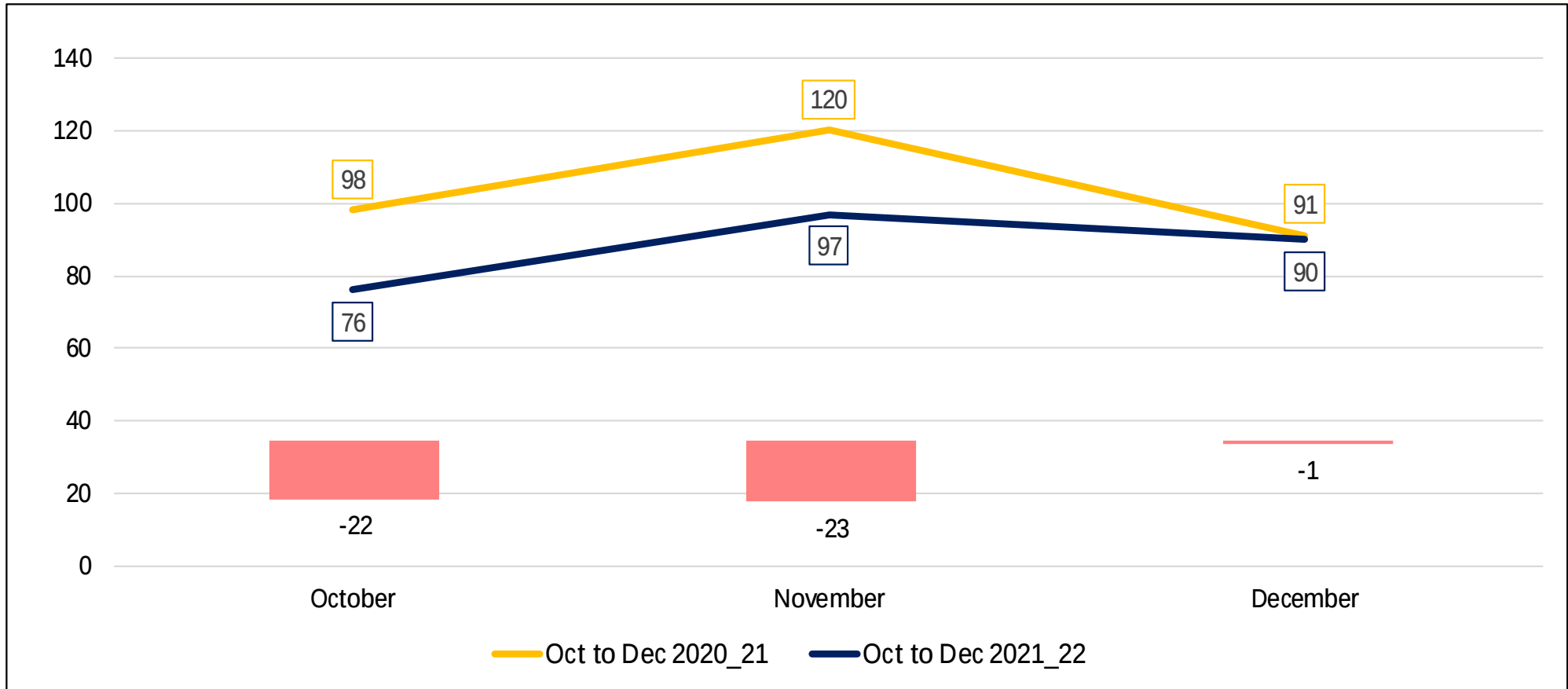
