

However, he alleges that nothing has come forth and as a result they are still stuck in Ward 33. He further alleges that after his mother passed on, he was appointed as the beneficiary of her estate and as such inherited the said stand which had a shack at the time. MPL Mabunda P | <p><b>Review of Framework for Churches: Ekurhuleni PP09B/07/17/LO</b></p> | <p><b>The petitioner is Pastor Anna Thembi, an adult female who resides at 5 Dhlamini Street, Kwa-Thema, submitting this petition on behalf of the Coalition of Ministers Council.</b> The petitioner alleges that they are a council of churches from Ekurhuleni and that they had previously requested to be given land on which they worship for free. She however alleges that instead of negotiating with the churches, the municipal council approved a framework which stipulates that all vacant land must be sold at a tender process. She further alleges that it is unfair on the churches as they have been worshipping on the land for years and that they will not be in a position to bid for the land due to financial constraints. 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| <p>9. <i>MPL Chabalala K</i></p> | <p><b>Permanent Stands Project: Mayfield</b><br/><br/><b>PP47D/03/21/LO</b></p> | <p><b>The petitioner is Mr. Peter Lewele, an adult male who resides at M60 Brown Street, Mayfield Ext 45, Daveyton, 1520 submitting this petition on behalf of the residents of Mayfield Ext 45.</b> The petitioner alleges that in 2017 the MMC for Human Settlements: Cllr Lesiba Mpya introduced a “permanent stands project” earmarked for the residents of Marikana, Baghdad and Lindelani. He further alleges that the first phase of allocating permanent stands went smoothly until the municipal officials (cited as Mr Zwane, Mr Ernest Shilambe and Mrs Mabatho) allowed the street committees to run the project and the allocations thereof. The petitioner further alleges that ever since the street committee started running the project, there has been several mixed-up allocations relative to the stand numbers. He further decries the relocation process under the stewardship of the street committee, to which he states that they are often given a short notice about being relocated and that they would also not be informed of where they are being relocated to.
