Driving Schools Registration

- The following Driving School Associations have signed an agreement of cooperation with the Department:
 - Gauteng Province Driving School Association (GPDSA)
 - Genuine Group Association (GGA)
 - Southern Africa Institute of Driving Instructors (SAIDI)
 - South African Driving Schools Association (SADSA)
 - South African National Association of Driving Schools (SANADS) and Independent Group
- National Organisation of Driving Schools of South Africa (NODSA) has not signed the agreement and has not been attending meetings with the Department
- The Department is working with CSIR and RTMC on the Driving School registration system
- The Department will be embarking on roadshows for the registration process
- Driving Schools are currently able to book for their clients
- The new system is available and is ready for deployment.
- The final meeting with driving schools and their legal representatives is awaited





Driving Schools Affairs Management Systems

- The Department of Roads and Transport is currently awaiting feedback from the Legal Section on the following documents:
 - Terms of Reference for the Gauteng Driving Schools Council (GDSC)
 - Agreement of Cooperation between the Department and Driving Schools
- The Department has agreed on an action plan with Driving School Associations, towards the registration of Driving Schools
- The GDSC will be established in September 2022
- The GDSC will consider and formalize the following as part of its programme:
 - Code of Conduct for Driving Schools
 - Learner driver training standards
 - Registration of Driving Schools
 - Rules and guidelines for driving instructors at a DLTC
