TRANSPORT & LOGISTICS COMMITTEE CONVENES PUBLIC HEARING ON MARINE OIL POLLUTION BILL

Portfolio Committee of Transport and Logistics, chaired by Honourable Gregory Schneeman will convene a public hearing on the Marine Oil Pollution (Preparedness, Response and Cooperation) Bill at the Auditorium in the Gauteng Legislature on Tuesday, 18th March 2025 at 13h00.

Marine Oil Pollution (Preparedness, Response and Cooperation) Bill [B10-2022] seeks to give effect to the International Convention on Oil Pollution Preparedness, Response and Cooperation of 1990 and to provide for matters connected therewith. In summary, the Bill provides for the processes to regulate, manage the preparedness and response to major marine oil pollution incidents at national level and as well as cooperation with other countries as necessary and appropriate.
